<b>Members' interests and dispensations</b>	There were none.

<b>Public questions raised</b>	
	<p><b>Announcement</b>  Re the Council's Statement of Licensing Policy (dealing with alcohol, entertainment, and late night refreshment) – A saturation policy can be applied where evidence exists that undue impact is being caused on the local community. The Council has agreed to monitor the situation in several areas. Among these is Shad Thames (Bermondsey). Further submissions can be sent to the Council's Licensing Service at any time up until the Committee's June meeting.</p>
	<p><b>Announcement</b>  Chair said that Cllr Kyriacou would be the new Chair of Bermondsey Community Council from the next meeting for a period of one year.</p>
<b>Q1</b>	<p><b>Re Bermondsey Youth Forum</b>  A resident congratulated the youths presenting on their work but asked why there was no mention of sport ? Further, they asked why did they not recruit members in local schools and have an afternoon event ?</p>
<b>A1</b>	<p>Alex from the youth forum replied that it was currently a small organisation and they were trying to concentrate on a lot of things. Sport was important and hopefully more things would get going in the future. They do engage with schools and are waiting for a number of replies. He invited anyone interested to come along to the Ellen Brown Centre.</p>
<b>Q2</b>	<p>A resident suggested that the youth forum organise a future community council. This could be held on a Saturday in the Ellen Brown Centre.</p>
<b>A2</b>	<p>Toni responded that the youth forum does a lot of work with the Council and would try to arrange many different things.</p>

	<p><b>Announcement</b></p> <p>Chair announced that Cllr Kyriacou during his year as Mayor had promoted voluntary work. She added that if anyone knew of someone in the community who they felt deserved recognition for their voluntary work then they should nominate them for an award.</p>
<b>Q3</b>	A resident asked about fences for the Four Squares football pitches and a public toilet in the square for use by residents and traders ?
<b>A</b>	Cllr Stanton said they were hoping to duplicate the football fence in use on the Longfield estate. Residents could now use the toilets in public buildings such as the library or Spa Road. However a new public toilet was probably too expensive.

<b>Q4</b>	Residents complained that lifts on several estates were faulty.
<b>A</b>	Chair said that these were matters for the housing forum and suggested residents contact Jane Martin.
<b>Q5</b>	A resident asked what was happening with the doctor and dental surgeries ?
<b>A</b>	Cllr Stanton said this was a matter for the Primary Care Trust. The PCT / NHS own it and they need to take it forward.
