Works Completed Week Starting 16/04/07

Temporary Signals	Temporary signals on site week 5 of 12. Situated at Browning St/ Manor Place junction.
Footway Widening Southbound	Paving outside the Old Town Hall – 151 Walworth Road was continued
Footway Widening Northbound	The Manor Place raised table was finished. Paving the footway outside 202 (McDonalds) was completed. The traffic islands and setts in Walworth Road at the Browning Street junction completed.
Ducting Works	Ducting between the newly laid islands at Browning Street/Manor Place was constructed with the islands.

Traffic Signals	The controller chip for the Signals at Manor Place Junction has been in testing. This chip will be able to be used. TfL will install the signals when the combined columns are ready.

One Week Ahead Week Starting 23/04/07

Temporary Signals	Temporary signals on site week 6 of 12. Situated at East Street. The signals at the Browning St/Manor Place junction will be reinstated until the new signals are installed.
Footway Widening Southbound	Continue paving outside the Old Town Hall – 151 Walworth Road Begin works on the East Street raised table plus kerb works along Walworth Road. East Street will be closed at Walworth Road for 3 weeks.
Footway Widening Northbound	Complete the loading bay outside 212.
Ducting Works	Begin ducting works for the East Street/Penrose Street signals.
Street Lighting	SMS to liase with FM Conway regarding civils assistance for combined column foundation.

Longer Term Programme

The East Street Raised Table begins 23/04/07 requiring the closure of East Street to Walworth Road for 3 weeks. Where works on the table finish ahead of programme East Street will be reopened.
Penrose Street raised table will start on May 14 th requiring the closure of Penrose Street to Walworth Road for 3 weeks. The P5 bus will be diverted from Walworth Road at Manor Place.
