<b>ii.</b>	<u>Pavement works</u> When will F W Conway be repairing the damage they are responsible for in Danville Road and removing their container? (Mr Marten)	<b>Emma Ellis</b>
<b>iii.</b>	As many <u>Cleaner Greener</u> allocations seem not to materialise could we have a one line progress report on all of them at the next meeting, and a update at all future meetings on current and outstanding projects please? (Mr Marten)	<b>Emma Ellis</b>
<b>iv.</b>	<u>King George 6<sup>th</sup> Memorial</u> (67 Crawford Road) Are Members aware of the intention to demolish this building and its low boundary wall? This is before a planning application has been submitted for the site. I understand Legal have today notified Planning of the two preserved trees on the site and the need to protect them during demolition. Personally, I am very concerned that a scruffy, but, in my opinion (as a building surveyer) structurally sound building that could be economically refurbished for its original purpose, should be raised to the ground, when there is very little prospect of the Housing Corporation funding the, as yet, unsubmitted proposals for the site in the foreseeable future. (This would) Potentially leave Camberwell with a ghastly hoarded building site for years. Representation should be made to Planning before the 7 <sup>th</sup> October 2008 (meeting).
