Something Else by Kathryn Cave : PSHE/writing activities

- Sharing – one skill/talent that you have and one skill/talent that you would like to swap with a friend
- Similarities and differences – Something Else looks different but does many things the same as us – list similarities and differences
- Something Else – writing a letter from the character’s perspective stating how you felt when others behaved in the way that they did
- Feelings and emotions – brainstorm words – find alternative words to express feelings
- Discrimination – Explain to the characters in the book what they did wrong in their behaviour towards Something Else
- Making a game – try and develop a game with rules where you could include Something Else
- Describe a human being from the perspective of Something Else
- Moving to a new place – list of actions you need to take to make new friends

Art	Draw your own ‘Something Else’ strange but friendly character
Drama	Reviewing the time when Something Else tried to join in – group activity to make the ending more positive
History	Examples in history of discrimination
Geography	Different people/ different lands
RE	Similarities and differences in world religions
Music	Strange music composition
Maths	Make a ‘Something Else’ character out of 2D shapes
