After consultation closes, this publication/ submission of the AAP and your comments will be sent to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government in March 2010. A government inspector will then examine whether the AAP meets their standards and will provide us with a final AAP for our agreement.

You may comment on the Canada Water AAP publication/submission version between 29 January 2010 and 12 March 2010. Your comments should relate to the soundness of the AAP. All comments must be received by 5pm on 12 March 2010 if you wish for them to be considered as part of the inspector's examination. Comments will not be accepted after this date.
