Canada Water

We are writing in connection with your emails of 27 and 28 September in which you asked for clarification on the number of representations submitted in respect of the Canada Water AAP.

Please find attached a short statement (CDCW24) which seeks to clarify the submitted consultation statement (CD CW3). With regard to the specific points you raise in your emails:

CD CW3, para 2.2.5: It should be noted there is a typographic error in the first sentence of 2.2.5. It should refer to the publication/submission stage, rather than the preferred options stage.

CD CW3, para 1.3.73: It should be noted that there is a typographic error in paragraph 3.1.73 of CD CW3. The paragraph relates to the youth consultation event. 24 questionnaires were completed during the event. The questionnaires and a summary of responses are provided in appendix 15 of CD CW3 and not appendix 17 as stated in 3.1.73.

Number of representors at publication stage: 29 people and organisations made representations. These representors, together with their identification number in our access database base, are listed in appendix 1 of the attached paper.

Number of representations made at publication stage: 268. Appendix 17 of CD CW3 contains a table with the representations made at

publication stage and the council's response. There are 270 representations in this table. The reason for the discrepancy with the current figure is that since the AAP was submitted, the database of representations has been rechecked and two duplicate representations have been deleted.

Appendices 16 and 17: Appendix 17 contains solely those representations made at publication stage. Appendix 16 contains representations made at scoping stage, issues and options stage and preferred options stage. There are no publication draft (Regulation 28) representations in appendix 16.

It should be noted that although the formal consultation period closed on 12 March, the council accepted representations until 16 March. The delegated report which noted the representations received and which approved minor amendments to the AAP was finalised on 17 March and signed on 18 March. The dates on which representations were received have been entered into the representations database.

Since 17 March, we are aware that a number of representors have continued submitting comments and representations. These are not currently in the database. However, we will gather these together and forward to you, in electronic and hard copy, to ensure that you have everything available.


Also attached is an Excel file with CD CW3 appendices 16 and 17 extracted into a spreadsheet, as requested.

We have not been successful in exporting the access database of representations on the publication draft into a spreadsheet, possibly because the amount of text within the several of the cells exceeds the limit which can be copied into an excel cell. However, the access database is available and we will forward it to you on a CD. It is easy to interrogate and the information can be sorted in a number of ways.

We have been through the database again and checked that where representors have asked to attend the hearing, this is accurately recorded.
