



Notice of Review of Polling Districts and Polling Places

Sections 18A, 18B, 18C, 18D and 18E and Schedule A1 of the Representation of the People Act 1983

Notice is hereby given that the London Borough of Southwark is undertaking a review of polling districts and polling places.

Representations will be sought from the Acting Returning Officer for the three parliamentary constituencies covered in full or part, and from persons who are considered to have particular expertise in relation to access to premises or facilities for persons who have different forms of disability.

Electors registered within the London Borough of Southwark or within the constituency of Dulwich and West Norwood are also invited to make representations as part of this review.

Any representations regarding the existing or proposed situation should be made in writing and provide alternative places that may be used as polling stations.

The review will commence on July 29 2011, and the deadline for representations is September 16 2011.
