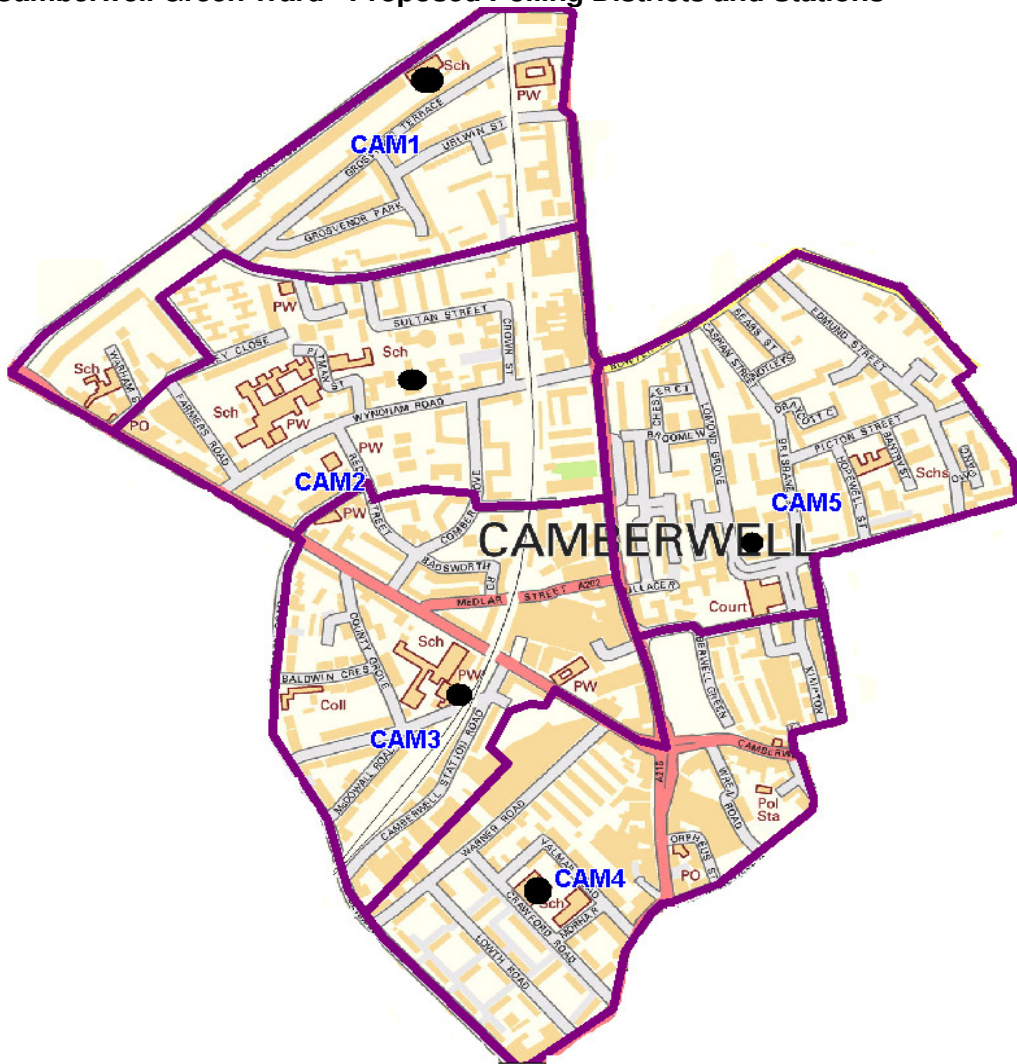


Camberwell Green Ward - Proposed Polling Districts and Stations



Polling District	Proposed polling station	Projected Electorate*	Proposed Changes from previous Polling districts and reasons
CAM1	John Ruskin Primary School, John Ruskin Street	1533	It is proposed that the area around Aberfeldy House/ Warham Street that was previously in CAM2 become part of CAM1 due to the size of CAM2 and the direct access to the polling station along John Ruskin Street.
CAM2	Jessie Duffett Tenants Hall, (Wyndham Hall), Wyndham Road	1986	To reduce in size (currently over 2800) as described in changes to CAM 1 and CAM3
CAM3	Sacred Heart Parish Centre, Knatchbull Road	1062	Area south of Councillor Street/Blucher Road and north of Camberwell New Road was previously part of CAM2 polling district. It is proposed that this join to CAM3 due to the size of CAM2 and access to the polling station.
CAM4	Crawford Primary Sch, Crawford Road	1666	The part of CAM4 north of Camberwell Church Street was previously part of CAM 5 which was very close to the maximum electorate figure.
CAM5	Camberwell Salvation Army, 105 Lomond Gr	2193	See CAM4

* The projected electorate is the number of Parliamentary electors due to go to the polling station (i.e. excluding postal voters) based on the register totals at the last general election. It does not included new developments that are likely to complete within the next 4 years which have also been factored in to the recommendations.
