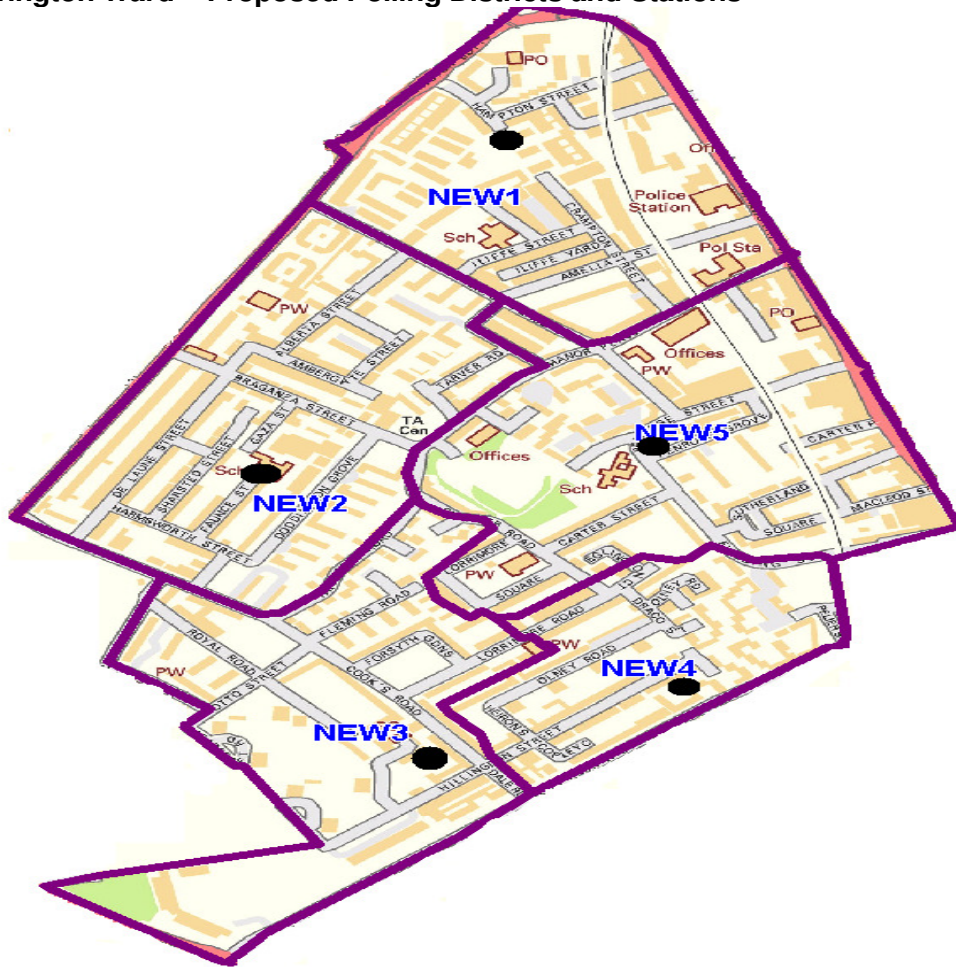


Newington Ward - Proposed Polling Districts and Stations



Polling District	Proposed polling station	Projected Electorate*	Proposed Changes from previous Polling districts and reasons
NEW1	Newington Estate TA Hall, 77 Canterbury Place	1694	NEW1 previously included the area around Alberta Street/Ambergate Street. It is proposed that this is moved to NEW2. This is because other parts of NEW1 have grown in population significantly due to developments such as the Strata and 22 Amilia Street.
NEW2	Keyworth Primary School, Faunce Street	2028	To add the above properties from NEW1 polling district to NEW2. Additionally the area around Royal Road and north of Otto Street was previously part of NEW2 but is proposed to become part of NEW3.
NEW3	Brandon Library, 17 Maddock Way	1794	NEW3 is proposed to increase as described above. The following properties were previously also in NEW 3 but it is proposed that they now move to NEW 4 polling district: Lorrimore Road no 48-74, Churchward House, and 37-97 Lorrimore.
NEW4	Pelier Community Hall, 19 Hillingdon St.	930	See NEW3
NEW5	Surrey Gardens Memorial Hall, Penrose Street	1353	NEW5 to remain unchanged except to add the block consisting of Berryfields and Penton Place from NEW2 as these electors will be nearer to this polling station and it will help to achieve a better balance between the polling districts.

* The projected electorate is the number of Parliamentary electors due to go to the polling station (i.e. excluding postal voters) based on the register totals at the last general election. It does not included new developments that are likely to complete within the next 4 years which have also been factored in to the recommendations.
