The London Borough of Southwark (Housing estate roads and car parks) (No. *) Order 202*

- Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above order under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the order will be:-
 - (a) FORBES COURT, to introduce the permit parking zone 'E-FC' into the estate roads and car parks fronting or adjacent to properties in Forbes Court;
 - (b) GOULD COURT, to introduce the permit parking zone 'E-GC' into the estate roads and car parks fronting or adjacent to properties in Gould Court; and
 - (c) NORTH PECKHAM ESTATE, to introduce the permit parking zone 'E-NP' into the estate roads and car parks fronting or adjacent to properties in Amstel Court, Blackthorne Court, Blossom Court, Danube Court, Indus Court, Leyland Court, Oak Court, Palm Court, Pear Court, Rowan Court, Shannon Court, Thames Court, Nos. 56, 58, 66, 68 and 70 Chandler Way, Nos. 1-126 Cronin Street, Nos. 1-8 Dorton Close, Nos. 18-68 East Surrey Grove, Nos. 1-60 Garnies Close, Nos. 1-67 Pentridge Street, No. 100 Pentridge Street, Nos. 1-8 Potter Close, and Nos. 1-12 Samuel Street.

Note: Where new estate parking zones are introduced existing uncontrolled parking places in the estate roads and car parks will be designated as permit holders' parking for use of the residents; business; visitors; or carers' permit holders of the designated zones only. Any existing disabled persons' parking places will continue to operate as before, and any area not designated as parking, will be subject to 'no waiting at any time' controls.
