Crawford Road - new pedestrian crossing

The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'K') (No. *) Order 20**

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above order under the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the order would be in CRAWFORD ROAD (CPZ'K') the south-west side, to reduce by 18 metres in length an existing permit parking place o/s Whitham House to accommodate a new raised pedestrian zebra crossing outside Crawford Primary School.
- 3. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE that it has approved under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the provision of a raised 'zebra' pedestrian crossing at the following location:-

CRAWFORD ROAD, the centre of which would be located 52 metres south-east of the southeastern kerb-line of Valmar Road as measured from the north-eastern side.

Zig-zag markings, on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times would be laid on (i) the north-east side, 8 metres north-west of and 4 metres south-east of this crossing, and (ii) the south-west side 4 metres north-west of and 8 metres south-east of this crossing.

4. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980² and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999³, propose to construct a speed table of flat-top construction having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway, at the following location:-CRAWEORD ROAD extending from a point 3 metres south-east of the porth-western wall of

CRAWFORD ROAD extending from a point 3 metres south-east of the north-western wall of Whitham House south-eastward for a distance of 6.5 metres.

Statement of reasons



Crawford Road - new pedestrian crossing

The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'K') (No. *) Order 20**

As part of Southwark Council's School improvement Programme and by the request of local residents, improvements to the area fronting Crawford Primary School have been proposed. The scheme will make improvements to Crawford Road (between its junctions with Valmar Road and Morna Road), in the Camberwell Green ward of the London Borough of Southwark.


The proposed scheme will provide a new raised zebra pedestrian crossing in Crawford Road; install new blister tactiles, a surface upgrade and the resurfacing the full carriageway between Valmar Road and Morna Road.

An existing permit holders' parking place (within controlled parking zone 'K') will be shortened by 18 metres to accommodate the installation of the new crossing. 40.5 metres of this parking place will remain.

Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'K') (No. *) Order 20** and shall come into force on xx xxxxxx 20**.

Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

"the Order of 2015" means The London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'K') (No. 1) Order 2015^b.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2015 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Revocation

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the designation by the Order of 2015 of the parking place numbered 39 in Schedule 1 therein is hereby revoked.

Designation of parking place and application of the Order of 2015 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column (2) of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2015 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to the areas described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a designated parking place or to a parking place shall include a reference to the area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2015 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

5.1 The council shall:-

- (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
- (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such a parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 4.1 and 4.2, as the case may be, of the Order of 2015;
- (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.
