The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 20**

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be:-
- (a) in CHELTENHAM ROAD the south-west side, to introduce a new loading only bay 15 metres in length, which would operate at any time (max stay 40 mins, and no return within 1 hour) o/s Nos. 120 and 122 Cheltenham Road:
- (b) to amend the existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) at the junction of Cheltenham Road and lvydale Road;
- (c) to formalise the existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions in Hawkslade Road and Kelvington Road (south-east of Cheltenham Road); and
- (d) to introduce 'at any time' loading restrictions (double yellow kerb blips) in the following locations: CHELTENHAM ROAD (i) the north-east side, south-east of its junction with Surrey Road and at its junction with Ivydale Road, and (ii) the south-west side at its junction with Kelvington Road; IVYDALE ROAD the north-west side, at its junction with Cheltenham Road; KELVINGTON ROAD the north-west side, at its junction with Cheltenham Road; and SURREY ROAD the south-east side, at its junction with Cheltenham Road.

Statement of reasons

Cheltenham Road area improvements

The London Borough of Southwark (Loading bays) (No. *) Traffic Order 20**
The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *)
Order 20**

As part of their Road Modernisation Plan, Transport for London (TfL) has identified improvements to the highway in the Cheltenham Road area (between its junctions with Surrey Road and Ivydale/Kelvington Road) which would reduce bus journey times.

The proposed scheme provides improvements to pedestrian journeys and bus journeys as conditions for crossing Kelvington Road will be improved and buses will be able to manoeuvre quickly and safely into the bus lane to serve the bus-stop.

The scheme proposes the following changes in the Cheltenham Road area (within the Peckham Rye ward, in the London Borough of Southwark):

- introduce a new loading bay in Cheltenham Road which would operate at any time (max stay 40 mins and no return within 1 hour);
- amend or formalise existing 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) in Cheltenham Road, Hawkslade Road, Ivydale Road and Kelvington Road as junction protection;
- introduce new 'at any time' loading restrictions (double kerb blips) in Cheltenham Road, lvydale Road Kelvington Road and Surrey Road.



- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2015 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

Designation of loading bay and application of the Order of 2016 thereto

- 3.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, is designated as a loading bay.
- 3.2 The provisions of the Order of 2016 (other than Articles 3.1 and 12.1) shall apply to each area designated as a loading bay by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a loading bay shall include a reference to each area designated as a loading bay by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2016 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 4.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each loading bay referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each loading bay referred to in the Schedule to this Order, traffic signs indicating that such a loading bay may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles referred to in Article 4.1 of the Order of 2016; and
 - (c) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a loading bay.
