OFFENSIVE/HYGIENE: European Waste Code 18 01 04	<input type="checkbox"/>	Offensive/hygiene waste – waste (not including sharps) whose collection and disposal is <u>not</u> subject to special requirements to prevent infection risks. This may include dressings, linen, disposable clothing and items used to contain and dispose of urine, faeces and other bodily secretions, or healthcare wastes that do not fall within European Waste Code 18 01 03 definitions. Includes disposable bedpans or bed linens, incontinence pads, stoma bags etc.

Guidance notes for clinicians completing this form

1. This form needs to be completed by the qualified clinician who is providing care to the patient – this can be a Doctor or registered Nurse (or other equivalent registered professional). The form requires assessment and certification of the type of waste to be collected, and the clinician is responsible for confirming the waste type code and ensuring all information needed for safe collection and disposal is provided.
2. The council does not provide collections of drugs, pharmaceutical products or medical equipment or devices through the clinical waste collection service. Radioactive, cytotoxic or cytostatic materials, and wastes which include infectious agents should be disposed of by the health care provider.
