St Francis RC Primary School – Friary Road permanent timed closure during term time

The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (No. *) Order 20**

The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed Route) (Friary Road) Traffic Order 20**

The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 20**

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be in FRIARY ROAD: -
 - (a) on the south-west side, (i) to split an existing 'short-stay' free parking place by removing 6 metres of parking space and (ii) to install 6 metres of 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) at this location; and
 - (b) to prohibit all vehicles, except pedal cycles, from entering into or proceeding in any part of Friary Road that lies between its north-western extremity and a point 20 metres north-west of its junction with Bird In Bush Road.
 - The timed road closure will be effective on Mondays to Fridays between the hours of 8:30 am to 9:15 am and 3 pm to 4 pm during the school-term (the dates of which are determined by the staff of St Francis RC Primary School) and will be physically enforced with the installation of a movable barrier located in Friary Road, 20 metres north-west of its junction with Bird In Bush Road.

Statement of reasons

St Francis RC Primary School – Friary Road permanent timed closure during term time

The London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (No. *) Order 20**
The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed Route) (Friary Road) Traffic Order 20**
The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 20**

The decision has been made to implement the trialled school street closure on Friary Road outside St Francis Primary School (within the Old Kent Road ward, in the London Borough of Southwark) on a permanent basis. There are changes to the trialled scheme, described below, which require statutory consultation prior to implementation.

This closure will prohibit all vehicles, except pedal cycles, from entering into or proceeding in any part of Friary Road that lies between its north-western extremity and a point 20 metres north-west of its junction with Bird In Bush Road, during certain times on school days within the school term.

The installation of the moveable bollards require an existing 'short stay' parking space to be split and to install 6 metres of 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) at this location.

- the timed road closure will be effective on Mondays to Fridays between the hours of 8:30 am to 9:15 am and 3 pm to 4 pm during the school-term;
- the closure will use moveable bollards (located 20 metres north-west of its junction with Bird In Bush Road) which will be erected and removed by school staff;
- closure will not be enforced outside of term time or at weekends;
- pedal cycles and permitted vehicles will not be subjected to any restrictions;
- timings of the road closure may be reduced at the discretion of the school.


The staff at school, who are responsible for the enforcement of the timed road closure within their School Street, will define the exact dates of the school term and when the timed road closure applies, and grant access to those who have requested it in writing.

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed route) (Friary Road)

Traffic Order 20** and shall come into force on xx xxxxxxxxx 20**.

Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

causing includes permitting;

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"kerb-line" means the imaginary line which is the projection of the line formed by the edge of the carriageway of a street;

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002^b:

"permitted vehicles" means any motor vehicle which has previously been granted dispensation from the restrictions within Article 3, as arranged and managed by the local authority;

"prescribed routes", for the purposes of Article 4 means any street or part of street referred to in Article 3 of this Order; and

"prohibited hours" means the period during the St Francis RC Primary School term from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30 am - 9:15 am and 3 pm - 4 pm.

2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

Prescribed routes

3.1 Friary Road

No person shall cause any vehicle, except pedal cycles and permitted vehicles, to enter into or proceed in any part of Friary Road which lies between a point 26 metres north-west of the northern kerb-line of Bird in Bush Road and its north-western extremity during the prohibited hours.

Exemptions

- 4.1 Nothing in Article 3 above shall apply in relation to:
 - a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any permitted vehicle as prescribed by Southwark Council;
 - (e) any vehicle being used for the maintenance, improvement, re-construction, cleansing or lighting of that part of street; and
 - (f) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to that part of street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any electronic communications network; or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of street.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order prohibits all vehicles except pedal cycles and permitted vehicles, from entering or proceeding in that part of Friary Road which lies between a point 26 metres north-west of the northern kerb-line of Bird in Bush Road and its north-western extremity during the school term (as determined by St Francis RC Primary School) Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:30 am - 9:15 am and 3 pm - 4 pm so as to encourage road safety and improve air quality in the areas surrounding St Francis RC Primary School, in the London Borough of Southwark.

Revocation

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the designation by the London Borough of Southwark (Free parking places) (No. 24) Order 2020^c of the parking place numbered 310 (Friary Road) in the Schedule therein is hereby revoked.

Designation of parking place and application of the Order of 2015 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2015 (other than Articles 3.1 and 13.1) shall apply to each area described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place shall include a reference to each area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to the Schedule to the Order of 2015 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such a parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Article 4.1 of the Order of 2015; and
 - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.
