- (b) COLNBROOK STREET, to formalise two pay parking places in CPZ 'C2' (i) north-west side o/s St Jude's Church and (ii) south-east side o/s No. 1 Colnbrook Street;
- (c) HALF MOON LANE north-west side o/s Nos. 141 to 145 Half Moon Lane, change the operating hours of existing 'short stay' parking place to Mon – Sun between 8.30 am and 6.30 pm (max stay 30 mins and no return within 2 hrs);
- (d) MUNTON ROAD, to relocate an existing solo motorcycle bay from the north side o/s Rosa Parks House to the south side o/s Victory Community Park (east of the existing permit parking bay);

- (I) add new 'at any time' (AAT) loading restrictions double kerb blips (DKBs), in the following locations: DOVERCOURT ROAD on both sides at its junction with Townley Road (7.5m per side), DULWICH VILLAGE south-west side 15m o/s Dulwich Hamlet Junior School, GREAT SUFFOLK STREET on both sides between its junctions with Dolben Street and Lavington Street (15m per side), TOWNLEY ROAD on both sides o/s Alleyn's School (28m per side), and WINDSOR WALK o/s The Phoenix public house (i) the north-west to south-west arm, 15m on the north-east side and 8.5m on the south-west side, (ii) the north-east to south-west arm 9m (per side).

Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE that it has approved under section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the provision of a raised 'zebra' pedestrian crossing in:- TOWNLEY ROAD, the centre of which would be located 23m north-west of the common boundary of Nos. 22 and 24 Townley Road. Zig-zag markings, on which vehicles would be prohibited from stopping at all times, would be (i) on the north-east side of the road for a distance of 8m north-west of and 4m south-east of this crossing, and (ii) on the south-west side of the road for a distance of 4m north-west of and 8m south-east of this crossing.
- 4. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980 and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999, propose to construct speed tables of flat-top construction having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the entire width of the carriageway, at the following locations:-TOWNLEY ROAD, extending from a point 18m north-west of the common boundary of Nos. 22 and 24 Townley Road north-westward for a distance of 9m; and

WOOD'S ROAD, extending from a point 26m west of the western kerb-line of Colmore Mews westward for a distance of 6 metres.

Revocation

3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done, or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the designation by the Order of 2015 of the parking places numbered 124 (Half Moon Lane) and 246 (Windsor Walk) in the Schedule therein is hereby revoked.

Designation of parking place and application of the Order of 2015 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2015 (other than Articles 3.1 and 13.1) shall apply to each area described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a parking place shall include a reference to each area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to the Schedule to the Order of 2015 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

"civil enforcement officer" means a person in uniform authorised by or on behalf of the Council in accordance with section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004^c to enforce and supervise the provisions of this Order;

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"driver", in relation to a vehicle waiting in a parking place, means the person driving the vehicle at the time it was left in the parking place;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"kerb-line" means the imaginary line which is the projection of the line formed by the edge of the carriageway of a street;

"minimum return interval" means the minimum period of time, following a vehicle having been taken away from a parking place during the permitted hours, before that vehicle may again be left in that parking place during the permitted hours;

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 20** and shall come into force on xx xxxxxx 20**.

Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

"the Order of 2015" means the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) Consolidation Order 2015^b - as amended.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2015 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

This Order:-

- amends existing lengths of 'at any time' waiting restrictions in Abbey Street, Alleyn Park, Athenlay Road Colnbrook Street, Elephant Lane, Farmers Road, Hansler Road, Hillsboro Road, Little Bornes, Maltby Street, Munton Road, Ophir Terrace, Stevenson Crescent, Townley Road, Windsor Walk, Wood's Road and Worlingham Road;
- (ii) introduces new lengths of 'at any time' waiting restrictions in Kelvington Road, King Stairs Close and Pioneer Street; and
- (iii) introduces new lengths of 'at any time' loading restrictions in Dovercourt Road, Dulwich Village, Great Suffolk Street, Townley Road, and Windsor Walk,

in the London Borough of Southwark.
