note: 'permit place/s' refer to parking places for holders of valid parking permits within the Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) listed; and 'shared-use place/s' refer to parking places in which holders of a valid permit for the CPZ listed or paid ticket holders are permitted to park within the hours of operation. All measurements are in metres 'm' and are approximate.

(a) to provide cycle hangars on the carriageway, each 2.55 metres in length, 2.05 metres in width and aligned parallel to the kerb, at the following locations:-

BALACLAVA ROAD the north-west side, 8m north-east of its junction with Fort Road;

CRAMPTON STREET the south-west side, between its junctions with Iliffe Street and Iliffe Yard;

DANECROFT ROAD two hangars on the south-west side, (i) to the side of No. 51 Herne Hill and (ii) to the side of No. 14 Elmwood Road;

DE LAUNE STREET the south-west side, opposite No. 1 Kennington Park Place;

DOWNTOWN ROAD the south-east side, between its junctions with Steers Way and Salter Road;

DULWICH WOOD AVENUE two hangars on the north-east side, (i) to the side of No. 2 Bell Meadow and (ii) opposite No. 23 Dulwich Wood Avenue:

DUNSTANS ROAD the south-east side, opposite No. 212 Dunstans Road;

FORT ROAD the north-east side, outside No. 143 Fort Road;

FURLEY ROAD the north-east side, to the side of No. 57 Fenham Road:

GLENGALL ROAD the north-east side, to the side of No. 19 Bird in Bush Road;

GROVE LANE the south-west side, between its junctions with Daneville Road and Kerfield Crescent:

HOWLETTS ROAD the south-west side, to the side of No. 24 Warmington Road;

LOVE WALK two hangars on the south-east side, (i) *outside* No. 7 Love Walk and (ii) *outside* No. 34 Love Walk:

MARSDEN ROAD the north-east side, to the side of No. 55 Ondine Road;

NORTH CROSS ROAD the south side, to the side of No. 92 Crystal Palace Road;

OXENFORD STREET the north-west side, to the side of No. 105 Copleston Road;

RAINBOW STREET the south-east side, outside Nos. 1 to 11 Rainbow Street;

ST GILES ROAD the south-west side, opposite No. 1 St Giles Road;

SURREY ROAD two hangars on the north-west side, both to the side of No. 12 Inverton Road;

TALFOURD ROAD the south-west side, outside No. 28 Talfourd Road;

TENDA ROAD the south side, outside Domino House, Tenda Road;

WORLINGHAM ROAD the south-east side, to the side of No. 10 Crawthew Grove; and

WYNEHAM ROAD the north-east side, to the side of No. 45 Beckwith Road;

(b) to provide two cycle hangars on the footway, each 2.55 metres in length and 2.05 metres in width, between GROVE LANE and STORIES ROAD aligned parallel to the south-easternmost edge of the footway, from a point 20.5 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Grove Lane north-eastward for a distance of 5.5 metres.

The measures in 2 (c)-(k) are proposed so as to accommodate the provision of the new cycle hangars in locations referred to above.

- (c) in CPZ 'E', to reduce in length an existing permit place in DE LAUNE STREET;
- (d) in CPZ 'EC', to reduce in length existing permit places in (i) RAINBOW STREET and (ii) ST GILES ROAD:
- (e) in CPZ 'HH', to reduce in length an existing 'shared-use' place in HOWLETTS ROAD;



- (f) in CPZ 'L', to reduce in length existing permit places in (i) GROVE LANE and (ii) LOVE WALK (two locations):
- (g) in CPZ 'P', (i) remove a permit place in DANECROFT ROAD 6m in length (side of No. 14 Elmwood Road) and reduces in length an existing permit place in WYNEHAM ROAD and (ii) reduces in length an existing 'shared-use' place in DANECROFT ROAD;
- (h) in CPZ 'PR', to reduce in length an existing permit place in TALFOURD ROAD;
- (i) in CPZ 'PW', to reduce in length existing permit places in (i) MARSDEN ROAD and (ii) OXENFORD STREET:
- (j) in CPZ 'TS', to reduce in length existing permit places in (i) BALACLAVA ROAD and (ii) FORT ROAD; and
- (k) adds new lengths of 'at any time' waiting restrictions in DANECROFT ROAD, DOWNTOWN ROAD, DULWICH WOOD AVENUE, DUNSTANS ROAD and NORTH CROSS ROAD.

Introducing cycle hangars forms a part of Southwark Council's objective to significantly increase the number of residents using a bicycle as their preferred mode of transport, particularly for local journeys. This is supported by the Mayor for London's Vision for Cycling.

The Council proposes to introduce **29 new cycle hangars** in the London Borough of Southwark within the following roads:

- Champion Hill ward footway between Grove Lane and Stories Road (two hangars);
- Dulwich Hill ward Dunstans Road;
- <u>Dulwich Village ward</u> Danecroft Road (two hangars), Howletts Road, Wyneham Road;
- <u>Dulwich Wood ward</u> Dulwich Wood Avenue (two hangars);
- Goose Green ward Marsden Road, North Cross Road, Worlingham Road;
- Newington ward Crampton Street, De Laune Street;
- Old Kent Road ward Glengall Road;
- Peckham ward Furley Road;
- Peckham Rye ward Surrey Road (two hangars);
- Rye Lane ward Oxenford Street;
- South Bermondsey ward Balaclava Road, Fort Road, Tenda Road;
- St Giles ward Grove Lane, Love Walk (2 hangars), Rainbow Street, St Giles Road, Talfourd Road;
- Surrey Docks ward Downtown Road.

Each cycle hangar is 2.55 metres in length and 2.05 metres in width and aligned parallel to the kerb. Where the cycle hangars are to be positioned on the carriageway, it may be necessary to amend the designation of existing parking and/or existing waiting and loading restrictions.

This Order reduces in length existing permit holders' parking places in Balaclava Road and Fort Road so as to accommodate the provision of new cycle hangars in the carriageway, in the London Borough of Southwark.

Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. *) Order 20** and shall come into force on xx xxxx 20**.

Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

"the Order of 2015" means the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) Consolidation Order 2015^b, as amended;

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2015 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.
