BELLENDEN ROAD the south-east side outside No. 179 Bellenden Road;

BOWEN DRIVE the north-east side, opposite No. 20 Bowen Drive;

BRANCH STREET the north-west side, outside No. 1 Branch Street;

CAMILLA ROAD two locations – the west side *between* Nos. 64 and 66 Camilla Road and the east side *opposite* Nos. 56 and 58 Camilla Road;

DANECROFT ROAD the south-west side, outside No. 30 Danecroft Road;

FELLBRIGG ROAD the south-east side, outside No. 17 Fellbrigg Road;

FIRBANK ROAD the north-west side, outside No. 10 Firbank Road;

GROSVENOR PARK the south-east side, outside No. 63 Grosvenor Park;

HILLSBORO ROAD the north-west side, outside No. 27 Hillsboro Road;

HOLLYDALE ROAD the south-west side, outside No. 57 Hollydale Road;

ILIFFE STREET the north-west side, the side of Nos. 17 to 24 Pullens Buildings, Penton Place;

KESTON ROAD the north-east side, outside No. 1 Keston Road;

note: the measures in 2 (b)-(m) are proposed so as to accommodate the provision of the new DPPPs and at the corresponding location referred to in 2(a) apart from 2(b.ii) which is proposed to accommodate the removal of an existing DPPP in Relf Road. 'permit place/s' refer to parking places for holders of valid parking permits within the Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ) listed. All measurements are in metres 'm' and are approximate.

- (b) in CPZ 'B': (i) LYNDHURST WAY to split and reduce in length by 6.6m an existing permit place, (ii) RELF ROAD to extend in length by 6m an existing permit place;
- (c) in CPZ 'E': ILIFFE STREET to reduce in length by 6.6m an existing permit place;
- (d) in CPZ 'ED': HILLSBORO ROAD to split and reduce in length by 6.6m a proposed permit place;
- (e) in CPZ 'G': OLD JAMAICA ROAD remove an existing permit place 7m;

- (I) to remove existing 'unlimited stay' DPPPs that are no longer needed in (i) RELF ROAD side of No. 18 Nigel Road and (ii) YORK GROVE outside No. 21 York Grove; and
- (m) in BRANCH ROAD to amend existing double yellow lines 'at any time' waiting restrictions.

The above-mentioned parking places will all be 6.6 metres in length and would operate at any time and without time limit by vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge'; and will necessitate:

- (i) amendments to existing double yellow lines in Branch Street and
- (ii) the reduction of some existing permit parking in Controlled Parking Zones (CPZs) 'B', 'E', 'G', 'M1', 'NC', 'P', 'PW', 'R'; and
- (iii) the reduction of some permit parking in proposed CPZs 'ED' and 'SEB' both due to be implemented winter 2020.



3.1 Without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order, the designation by the Order of 2020 of the parking places numbered 21 and 26 in Schedule 1 therein, are hereby revoked.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2020 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column (2) of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, and having a width of 2 metres throughout, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2020 (other than Articles 3, 16 and 17) shall apply to the areas described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a designated parking place or to a parking place shall include a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order, and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2020 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs, etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order:
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such parking places may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.2 of the Order of 2020;
 - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.
