

Tustin Estate newsletter

Welcome to the latest edition of the Tustin Estate monthly newsletter from Southwark Council.

The residents of the Tustin Estate have voted for the demolition and rebuild of Bowness House, Heversham House, Hillbeck Close and Kentmere House, and the refurbishment of the council houses on Manor Grove.

Cost of Living support

What is the latest on building the first phase of the new homes?

Bouygues UK, who is building the new homes have advised us given us the following update on three sites in phase one as follows:

- The demolition of Hillbeck Close and Ullswater House has been delayed by 2 weeks due to asbestos removal. The asbestos will be safely removed before demolition. The first expected collapse/knock down of building expected to happen at the end of November/beginning of December.
- On the Heversham
 House/Ilderton Road site the utilities continue to be disconnected. The ground

- investigation works are continuing. The retaining walls and landscaping are to be taken down and the ground levelled
- At Manor Grove the hoarding is to be installed in preparation for the demolition of the garages

The current proposals for the phases are:

- Phase 1 Begins autumn 2022 and completes spring 2025
- Phase 2 Begins summer 2025 and completes early 2028
- Phase 3 Begins summer 2026 and completes late 2028
- Phase 4 Begins late 2027 and completes summer 2030

Planning update

In July, Southwark planning authority granted permission for Tustin Phase 1, and outline permission for Phases 2-4. As part of the planning process Southwark planners were required to refer the application to the Mayor of London for his final decision, known as a Stage 2. The Mayor of London approved Stage 2 on 17 October 2022 and the decision notice has now been issued.

Christmas lights switch-on - 7 December

The Tustin Christmas lights switch-on will be held on Wednesday 7 December 2022. Please save the date. The time and venue will be confirmed shortly.

Development agreement update

In October 2022, Southwark Cabinet approved the development agreement

between the Council and Linkcity. We are pleased to say the Development Agreement has been signed. Works continue on site.

Options for resident leaseholders

We want to talk to all resident leaseholders about the new housing options available to you. As set out in the Tustin Estate Landlord Offer Document, every resident leaseholder who wants to stay living on the rebuilt Tustin Estate will be offered a new leasehold home that can be bought via shared ownership, shared equity, or equity loan with the council. There may be alternative options available for you if there are any affordability issues. Letters will be sent to you shortly.

Condition surveys for privately owned homes

Pulse Consult have been appointed to undertake condition surveys for the privately owned homes on the Tustin Estate. We think it is important to carry out these condition surveys so we can monitor any impact the construction works may have on your home and to enable us to repair any damage caused by the construction works and for which the Council is responsible as quickly and efficiently as possible. Getting ready to go on the Housing Register

In preparation for tenants in Kentmere House, Heversham House and Bowness House to be rehoused in the new homes that will be built on the Tustin Estate, we are working with them to get registered on the housing list.

Don't forget you will need this information to complete a housing application:

- National Insurance Number
- Identity please provide 1 form of identity for each adult (18 and above) (NB: if the name is different form the ID, please provide deed poll letter/marriage certificate to show name change):
 - Current British passport
 - British birth certificate
 - Current passport and/or Immigration documents
 - NB: Non-EU passports must show immigration visa stamp; Residence Permit card (both sides); settled or pre-settled status under the EU Settlement Scheme.
- Address Minimum 5 years of address history has to be shown, which can be achieved through 2 of the following documents showing the current address for each adult (over 18) in the household:
 - Full British driving licence (both sides)
 - o College/university confirmation
 - Recent bank statement
 - Tenancy Agreement (mandatory)
 - o Recent phone bill
 - Recent Council Tax bill
 - Pension details

- Electoral Register entry
- Educational Maintenance Allowance
- Recent bill for gas
- Recent bill/ book for electricity or water supply
- o P60
- Medical information if you have a medical need that affects your housing needs - GP details, medication(s), treatment(s), names of hospital(s) attended for health needs, names of any consultants involved in health needs
- Annual Household Income proof of income must be provided from one of the list below:
 - Confirmation from DWP letter showing name and address
 - Recent pay-slip
 - Letter from employer showing name and current address
 - Contract of employment
 - o P60
 - Bank statement showing wages
 - Voluntary National Insurance contributions
 - Pay and tax records
 - Recent Self-Assessment Tax return
 - Self-Assessment Employment Tax & National Insurance
- Community contribution If you or anyone on your application is currently volunteering for a charity in Southwark or in paid employment, please provide a confirmation letter from the manager. This must state your name and address, the number of hours worked per week and the date you started working.

We will be contacting each of the permanent tenants in Bowness House, Heversham House and Kentmere House, to help you get registered.

Appropriation

Southwark Council will be taking a report to the cabinet meeting on 6 December 2022, to appropriate Phase 1 of the development site under the Housing and Planning Act 2016, to override any rights affected to remove the possibility of anyone being able to stop the development based on any rights of way or light that they might have. This does not mean that the rights are removed but would instead allow for possible financial compensation.

Dumped rubbish

Energy saving tips

With the cost of living on the rise, there's never been a better time to cut your energy bills and be kind to the planet.
We've put together some tips to help you and your family reduce your energy use in every room of your home.

Over half of home energy bills spend goes on heating and hot water. It's really important to look at your home heating habits and see if there are small changes we can make to reduce our heating bills.

 Turn down your thermostat. Just one degree lower could save you up to £128 a year. Set a timer on your thermostat for your heating to come on only when you need it.



- Don't heat empty rooms.
 Individual radiator thermostats mean you can adjust the temperature in each room accordingly.
- Keep doors between adjoining rooms shut. This way, you stop the heat from escaping.
- Run your heating for an hour less each day. Even using a little less energy each day adds up to savings over time.
- Bleed your radiators. Trapped air can make your radiators less efficient, so they'll be slower to heat up.
- Keep the heat in. Simply closing your blinds or curtains in the evening can also stop heat loss by up to 17%. Just be sure your curtains don't cover the radiators.

Primary school admissions

Before applying for a primary school place for your child to start in the Reception year in September 2023, you should research all the schools that you and your child are interested in.

As a Southwark resident, you must apply online for a primary school place. You can find further information on completing an online school admissions application on our how to apply online page at

www.southwark.gov.uk.

When applying for a school place you can express a preference for up to six schools whether they're in Southwark or in another borough.

You must ensure that the online application is fully completed and that all details are entered correctly. Failure to tick certain boxes such as the sibling box, the social/medical box or the 'looked after child' box will mean that your application will not be considered under these criteria.

If you're providing additional documents to support your application you must upload these as an attachment with your online application before 11.59pm on 15 January 2023. Please do not post or email supporting documentation as we will not be able to accept these.



When you've completed your online application, you must submit it by the closing date of 15 January 2023 by 11.59pm. The online application will not be deemed as on time unless it's submitted by this time and date.
