Revocation of School Street near Goose Green Primary School

The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed Routes) (Tintagel Crescent) Traffic Order 2020

1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 20 August 2020 it has made the above order under sections 6 and 124, and Part IV of Schedule 9, of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹, as amended.
2. The general effects of the order are to revoke, in entirety, the Experimental Traffic Management Order: *The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Tintagel Crescent) Experimental Traffic Order 2019* (public notice originally advertised in *the London Gazette* on 15 August 2019²). Note: this revocation is to accommodate the relocation of this timed 'school street' in the vicinity of Goose Green Primary School.
3. Copies of the order, which will come into force on 24 August 2020, and of all other relevant documents are available for inspection at Highways, Southwark Council, Environment and Leisure, 3rd floor hub 2, 160 Tooley Street, London SE1 2QH, by appointment only. E-mail traffic.orders@southwark.gov.uk or call 020 7525 3497 for details.
4. Any person desiring to question the validity of the orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

Statement of reasons

Revocation of School Street near Goose Green Primary School

The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed Routes) (Tintagel Crescent) Traffic Order 2020

The decision has been made to relocate an existing timed 'school street' closure in the vicinity of Goose Green Primary School as implemented in August 2019 as part of the London Borough of Southwark 'school streets' programme (public notice originally advertised in *the London Gazette* on 15 August 2019¹).

In order to relocate the timed 'school street' and restart the trial anew, the Experimental Traffic Management Order pertaining to the Tintagel Crescent 'school street' is revoked in entirety, and remade with the new location as a part of London Streetspace Programme – East Dulwich.

Traffic Order 2020

Made: 20 August 2020

Coming into force: 24 August 2020

The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124, and Part IV of Schedule 9, of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984^a, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and commencement

- 1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Tintagel Crescent) Traffic Order 2020 and shall come into force on 24 August 2020.

Interpretation

- 2.1 In this Order:-

causing includes permitting;

“enactment” means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
