- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 20 August 2020 it has made the above experimental orders under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹.
- 2. The effects of the experimental orders are to make necessary changes to existing highway restrictions to accommodate footway widening in the vicinity of various schools, as implemented by the London Streetspace Programme: note: All measurements are in metres 'm' and are approximate.
- (a) COBOURG ROAD north-west side, o/s Cobourg Primary School two existing 'shared-use' parking places in CPZ 'T' are suspended (32.5m);
- (b) GLADSTONE STREET– in CPZ 'C2' (i) an existing permit holders parking place on north-west side is relocated to extend (by 10m) the existing parking place o/s Nos. 8 to 48 Gladstone Street, and ii) an existing permit holders parking place (39m) on south-east side opposite Notre Dame RC Girls School is suspended;
- (c) GOODRICH ROAD point road closure in which motor vehicles are prohibited to proceed is introduced north-west of its junction with Dunstans Road;
- (d) VARCOE ROAD introduce a banned right turn (left turn only) for all vehicles at the easternmost junction with Verney Road;
- (e) to add and amend 'at any time' waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) in the vicinity of the schools listed: i) COBOURG ROAD on both sides o/s Cobourg Primary School, ii) DUNSTANS ROAD northwest side o/s Goodrich Community Primary School, iii) ETHEROW STREET on both sides o/s St Anthony's RC Primary School, iv) GLADSTONE STREET on both sides between Notre Dame Girls School and St Jude's C of E Primary School, v) GOODRICH ROAD both sides o/s Goodrich Community Primary School, vi) HARPER ROAD on both sides o/s Globe Academy Primary School, vii) HEBER ROAD south side o/s Heber Primary School, viii) JENNINGS ROAD north side o/s Heber Primary School, ix) JOHN RUSKIN STREET south-east side o/s John Ruskin Primary School, x) LONCROFT ROAD north side o/s Cobourg Primary School, xi) MARMONT ROAD south-east side o/s Peckham Park Primary School, xii) UPLAND ROAD south-east side o/s Goodrich Community Primary School, xiii) VARCOE ROAD south and east side o/s Ilderton Primary School, xiv) WEST SQUARE north-west side o/s Charlotte Sharman Primary School, and xv) WOODS ROAD north and north-east side o/s John Donne Primary School; and
- (f) to add 'at any time' loading restrictions (double kerb blips) in the vicinity of the schools listed:
 i) HEBER ROAD south side o/s Heber Primary School, ii) JENNINGS ROAD north side o/s Heber Primary School, and iii) VARCOE ROAD south and east side o/s Ilderton Primary School.

- 4. Copies of the orders, which will come into force on 27 August 2020 (and expire on 7 March 2022), this notice, plans and a statement of the council's reasons for making the orders may be found online at www.southwark.gov.uk/trafficorders. The council will in due course be considering whether the provisions of the experimental order/s should be continued in force indefinitely, by means of a permanent order made under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Anyone wishing to object to the making of the permanent orders or make any other representation regarding the scheme would have 6 months to do so, from the date the experimental order comes into force (or, if the order is varied by a subsequent order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, from the date that variation order or modification comes into force), and may send a statement to traffic.orders@southwark.gov.uk or to: Traffic Order consultations, Highways, Southwark Council, Environment and Leisure, P.O. - 6. Under requirements of current access to information legislation, any letter or e-mail sent to the Council in response to this Notice may be subject to publication or disclosure, or both, including communication to other persons affected.

Anyone wishing to question the validity of the order/s or of any provision therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the order/s may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

Statement of reasons

London Streetspace Programme – Footway widening in the vicinity of schools

The decision has been made to trial necessary changes to existing highway restrictions to accommodate footway widening and prescribed routes in the vicinity of various schools in the London Borough of Southwark as part of the London Streetspace programme.

As 'lockdown' is lifted it is likely that social distancing measures are still likely to be required, and pupils and staff returning to schools will require extra space. A series of footway widening and prescribed routes are set to:

- provide more space for social distancing at pick-up and drop-off times
- improve road safety outside the vicinity of the school entrance
- provide a healthier environment and improve local air quality outside schools for vulnerable user groups
- encourage the use of active travel, such as walking, cycling, scooting or park and stride

The London Streetspace Programme aims to create more space on the streets so people can walk and cycle safely and observe social distancing.

A summary of the proposed schemes' details are as follows:

Note: All measurements are approximated and in metres 'm', 'DYLs' refer to double yellow lines ('at any time' waiting restrictions), 'DKBs' refer to double kerb blips ('at any time' loading restrictions), 'CPZ' refers to a Controlled Parking Zone and 'SKC' refers to School Keep Clear markings.

These measures are subject to experimental Traffic Management Orders (TMOs). A TMO is the legal mechanism the council, as traffic authority, uses to control aspects of the way that the highway is used. They provide the legal backing to signs and road markings used on the highway and allow them to be enforceable.

The experimental TMOs will be enforceable for a period up to 18 months to allow the assessment of any impact the road closures and other restrictions might have on the area and surrounding roads, and to revise the scheme if necessary within that time. A review will be carried out to assess the initial success of the scheme and whether the restrictions should be made permanent.


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
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
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

Suspension of designation of parking places

- 3.1 While this Order remains in force, and without prejudice to the validity of anything done or to any liability incurred in respect of any act or omission before the coming into force of this Order:-
 - (a) the designation by the Order of 2009 of the parking places numbered 44, 45 and 47 in Schedule 1 therein, are hereby suspended; and
 - (b) the designation by the London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (CPZ 'C2') (No. 26) Order 2018^c of the parking places numbered 188 and 189 in Schedule 1 therein, are hereby suspended.

Designation of parking places and application of the Order of 2009 thereto

- 4.1 Each area on a highway comprising the length of carriageway of a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order and bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway, is designated as a parking place.
- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2009 (other than Articles 3 and 15) shall apply to the areas described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a designated parking place or to a parking place shall include a reference to an area designated as a parking place by this Order and, as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2009 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such a parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.3 of the Order of 2009; and
 - (c) carry out such other works as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a parking place.

Power to modify or suspend this Order

6.1 In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Parking and Network Management Business Unit Manager (or such other officer of the council as holds the post of Traffic Manager as defined in section 17 of the Traffic Management Act 2004^d) may, if it appears to that officer essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend any provision of this Order, save that no modification shall make an addition.

Prescribed routes

Dunstans Road

No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in Dunstans Road shall, upon reaching its junction with Goodrich Road, cause that motor vehicle to enter or proceed into that part of Goodrich Road which lies north-west of that junction.

Goodrich Road

- 4.1 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in that part of Goodrich Road which lies northwest of a point 21 metres south-east of the south-eastern wall of No. 109 Goodrich Road shall. upon reaching that point, cause that motor vehicle to enter or proceed into that part of Goodrich Road which lies south-east of a point 21 metres south-east of the south-eastern wall of No. 109 Goodrich Road.
- No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in that part of Goodrich Road which lies south-4.2 east of a point 21 metres south-east of the south-eastern wall of No. 109 Goodrich Road shall, upon reaching that point, cause that motor vehicle to enter or proceed into that part of Goodrich Road which lies north-west of a point 21 metres south-east of the south-eastern wall of No. 109 Goodrich Road.

Exemptions

- 5.1 Nothing in Articles 3 and 4 above shall apply in relation to:
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency; (b)
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - any vehicle being used for the purpose of refuse collection, maintenance, improvement, re-(d) construction, cleansing or lighting of that part of street; and
 - (e) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to that part of street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any electronic communications network; or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of street.

Varcoe Road

- Every person causing any vehicle to proceed in a northern direction in Varcoe Road shall, upon reaching its easternmost junction with Verney Road, cause that vehicle to turn left into Verney
- 3.2 No person causing any vehicle to proceed in a northern direction in Varcoe Road shall, upon reaching its easternmost junction with Verney Road, cause that vehicle to turn right into Verney

Exemptions

- 4.1 Nothing in Article 3 above shall apply in relation to:
 - anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; (a)
 - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - any vehicle being used for the purpose of refuse collection, maintenance, improvement, (d) re-construction, cleansing or lighting of that part of street; and
 - any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or (e) adjacent to that part of street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any electronic communications network; or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of street.

Power to modify or suspend this Order

In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Road Network and Parking Business Unit Manager (or such other officer of the council as holds the post of Traffic Manager as defined in section 17 of the Traffic Management Act 2004b) may, if it appears to that officer essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend any provision of this Order, save that no modification shall make an addition.

Citation, commencement and expiry

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. 13) Experimental Traffic Order 2020, and shall come into force on 27 August 2020, and expires on 7 March 2022.

Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment; and

- "the Order of 2015" means the London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) Consolidation Order 2015^b as amended.
- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

This Order, by way of an experiment:-

- (a) amends existing waiting restrictions in Cobourg Road, Dunstans Road, Etherow Street, Gladstone Street, Goodrich Road, Harper Road, Heber Road, Jennings Road, John Ruskin Street, Loncroft Road, Marmont Road, Upland Road, Varcoe Road, West Square and Woods Road;
- (b) amends existing loading restrictions in Heber Road; and
- (c) adds 'at any time' loading restrictions in Jennings Road and Varcoe Road,

so as to accommodate footway widening in the vicinity of various schools, as implemented by the London Streetspace Programme - Schools, in the London Borough of Southwark.
