**NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF THE BLACKFRIARS ROAD SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING
DOCUMENT**

In accordance with Regulation 11 and Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that THE LONDON BOROUGH OF SOUTHWARK ("the Council") adopted the 'Blackfriars Road Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)' on **28 January 2014** and produced an Adoption Statement to this effect.

The purpose of the Blackfriars Road SPD is to provide information on how to implement the policies in the London Plan, Core Strategy and saved Southwark Plan.

The Blackfriars SPD sets out the Council's ideas of an emerging vision for the area and provides guidance on the following topics:

- Business space
- Mixed use town centre development
- Public realm and opens space
- Built form and heritage
- Building heights
- Active travel
- Implementation and partnership working.

The SPD is part of Southwark's planning policy framework and will be a material consideration in the determination of planning applications.

Copies of the Adoption Statement, the Blackfriars Road SPD, the Sustainability Appraisal, the Equalities Analysis, the Sustainability Appraisal Statement, the Appropriate Assessment and the Consultation Report are available for inspection free of charge on the Council's website; <https://www.southwark.gov.uk/blackfriarsroadspd> and at the locations and times listed below.

Any person aggrieved by the Blackfriars Road SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for judicial review of the decision to adopt the Blackfriars Road SPD, and any such application for leave must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date of adoption specified above. Any such application must be made by 28 April 2014.
