Public notice (section 90C) Traffic calming measures



- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980¹ and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Road humps) Regulations 1999² and the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999³, intend to place road humps of sinusoidal cross-section construction.
- 2. All road humps to be approximately 3.7 metres in length, having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the greater width of the carriageway, centred upon the following locations:-

(a) in AMOTT ROAD (within Goose Green ward and Rye Lane ward):

- (i) at the common boundary of Nos. 6 and 8 Amott Road;
- (ii) at the common boundary of Nos. 24 and 26 Amott Road;
- (iii) at the common boundary of Nos. 37 and 39 Amott Road;
- (iv) at the common boundary of Nos. 68 and 70 Amott Road.
- (b) in MONTPELIER ROAD (within Nunhead & Queens Road ward):
 - (i) at a point 2 metres south of the common boundary of Nos. 21 and 23 Montpelier Road;
 - (ii) at a point 2 metres south of the common boundary of Nos. 41 and 43 Montpelier Road;
 - (iii) at a point 1 metre south of the common boundary of Nos. 57 and 59 Montpelier Road;
 - (iv) at a point 4 metres south of the common boundary of Nos. 80 and 82 Montpelier Road.
