Answers: The criteria in setting up a new TRA: The first thing you need to consider when setting up a resident's association is what the group hopes to achieve. There must be a sufficient number of residents volunteering as a group, who are willing to represent the views and interest of everyone living in that particular area. The group will need to have the following in place: Form a committee with an elected Chairperson, Vice-Chairperson, Secretary, Treasurer and committee members. Adopt a constitution. Keep certain records and documents, like an up-to-date list of members, any other rules of the association.

Fly-tipping penalties system in place: Southwark Council have adopted and use the Fixed Penalty Notice, under Section 33 of the Environmental Protection Act 1990, to tackle the illegal deposits of waste (also known as Small Scale Fly tipping). 3. All reports of fly-tipping are contacted within 24 hours.
