The Timetable for Preparing Southwark's Planning Documents

# The Local Development Scheme

The Local Development Scheme (LDS) sets out the timetable for preparing Southwark's development plan and supplementary planning documents. This LDS will replace the December 2019 LDS. All of the documents mentioned can be found at [www.southwark.gov.uk/](http://www.southwark.gov.uk/)

The Amended Policies for the New Southwark Plan went out to consultation in January 2019, consultation has been taken into account and the Submission Version has been prepared and submitted in January 2020. The New Southwark Plan will go through another round of consultation between 28th August - 26th October 2020, this is in response to the Inspector's letter and the Covid-19 crisis making the initial timetable for an Examination in Public (EIP) no longer feasible. The NPPF update sets out that Local Plans should be more responsive with regular updates and a 5 year review rather than preparation of a new plan every 5 years. The LDS has been updated to show the new approach with amendments regularly rather than a 5 year update. First amendments are likely to include Town Centres, Gypsy and Travellers, Air Quality and Climate Emergency.

The Old Kent Road AAP consultation has been rescheduled for the earliest opportunity following the New Southwark Plan EIP, and the SPDs have been rescheduled for March 2021. This is in response to extra work required for the NSP following the Inspector's letter of initial matters and concerns, and the Covid-19 crisis.

The Gypsy and Travellers DPD has been removed and this will be part of the new process of annual amendments.

Planning documents not included in the LDS include conservation area appraisals, Article 4 directions, and policy statements. This is because these are normally prepared in response to an issue on a short timeframe. All planning documents are quality tested. This can include an Integrated Impact Assessment, Equalities Impact Assessment and Habitats Assessment. All planning documents set out how we are going to consult in a consultation plan and how we have consulted with summaries of comments and You Said, We Did reporting. These are considered by the decision maker when documents are agreed for consultation and at the final stage. All planning documents have a consultation plan for consideration by the decision maker at the start of consultation following the processes set out in the Statement of Community Involvement. They also have a consultation statement with the representations and how they have been addressed when a final document is agreed for consideration by the decision maker.
