- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that on 15 October 2020 it has made the above experimental orders under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>.
- 2. The effects of the experimental orders are to:-
- (a) introduce timed bus gates in which only buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles are permitted to enter and proceed during the period from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am 10 am and 3 pm 6 pm, in the following locations all of which will be ANPR camera enforced:

(i) BURBAGE ROAD (northernmost bus gate), the north-westbound lane of Burbage Road at the north-western kerb-line of Turney Road,

(ii) BURBAGE ROAD (southernmost bus gate), the westbound lane of Burbage Road at the north-western kerb-line of Gallery Road,

(iii) DULWICH VILLAGE, the northbound lane of Dulwich Village at the common boundary of Nos. 116 and 118 Dulwich Village,

(iv) TOWNLEY ROAD, the north-westbound lane of Townley Road at the common boundary of Nos. 52 and 53 Townley Road, and

(v) TURNEY ROAD, the north-eastbound lane of Turney Road at a point 10 metres north-east of the northeastern kerb-line of Burbage Road as measured from the north-eastern side of Turney Road;

- (b) BURBAGE ROAD, introduce a banned left turn for any motor vehicle, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles from Burbage Road at its junction with Turney Road from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am – 10 am and 3 pm – 6 pm;
- (c) CALTON AVENUE, introduce a banned left turn for any motor vehicle, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles from Calton Avenue at its junction with Townley Road from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am - 10 am and 3 pm - 6 pm;
- (d) TURNEY ROAD, introduce a banned right turn for any motor vehicle, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles from Turney Road at its junction with Burbage Road from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am – 10 am and 3 pm – 6 pm;
- (e) DULWICH VILLAGE, on both sides convert all waiting restrictions to 'at any time' (double yellow lines) from its junction with East Dulwich Grove/Village Way to (i) its junction with Turney Road on the south-west side, and (ii) and a point 7.5 metres south-east of its junction with Gilkes Place on the north-east side.

- 4. Copies of the orders, which will come into force on 22 October 2020 (and expire on 25 April 2022), this notice, plans and a statement of the council's reasons for making the orders may be found online at <u>www.southwark.gov.uk/trafficorders</u>. The council will in due course be considering whether the provisions of the experimental order/s should be continued in force indefinitely, by means of a permanent order made under section 6 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Anyone wishing to object to the making of the permanent orders or make any other representation regarding the scheme would have 6 months to do so, from the date the experimental order comes into force (or, if the order is varied by a subsequent order or modified pursuant to section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, from the date that variation order or modification comes into force), and may send a statement to traffic.orders@southwark.gov.uk or to: Traffic Order consultations, Highways, Southwark Council, Environment and Leisure, P.O. Box 64529, London SE1P 5LX; or use the form labelled 'Parking Road traffic and highway schemes responding to statutory consultation notices' at www.southwark.gov.uk/statutoryconsultationnotices quoting the reference 'TMO2021-EXP16\_LSP Dulwich 2'. Please note that if you wish to object to the scheme you must state the grounds on which your objection is made.
- 6. Under requirements of current access to information legislation, any letter or e-mail sent to the Council in response to this Notice may be subject to publication or disclosure, or both, including communication to other persons affected.
- 7. Anyone wishing to question the validity of the order/s or of any provision therein on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any of the relevant

requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made thereunder have not been complied with in relation to the order/s may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

### **Statement of reasons** London Streetspace Programme – Dulwich Phase 2



The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Burbage Road area) Experimental Traffic Order 2020 The London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Townley Road area) Experimental Traffic Order 2020 The London Borough of Southwark (Waiting and loading restrictions) (Amendment No. 19) Experimental Traffic Order 2020

The decision has been made to introduce a set of timed bus gates within Dulwich Village ward, in the London Borough of Southwark, as Phase 2 of the London Streetspace programme – Dulwich.

The London Streetspace Programme aims to repurpose the streets for the local community and businesses and safeguard local streets from a potential increase in traffic as a result of the significant reduction in public transport capacity. One of the key areas that we are looking at as part of this programme is to create low-traffic corridors to enable healthy streets for people to walk and cycle and enjoy more space for play and activities.

A summary of the schemes' details are as follows:

- (a) to introduce timed bus gates in which only buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles are permitted to enter and proceed during the period from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am 10 am and 3 pm 6 pm, in the following locations all of which will be ANPR camera enforced:
  - (i) BURBAGE ROAD (northernmost bus gate), the north-westbound lane of Burbage Road at the north-western kerb-line of Turney Road,
  - (ii) BURBAGE ROAD (southernmost bus gate), the westbound lane of Burbage Road at the north-western kerb-line of Gallery Road,
  - (iii) DULWICH VILLAGE, the northbound lane of Dulwich Village at the common boundary of Nos. 116 and 118 Dulwich Village,
  - (iv) TOWNLEY ROAD, the north-westbound lane of Townley Road at the common boundary of Nos. 52 and 53 Townley Road, and
  - TURNEY ROAD, the north-eastbound lane of Turney Road at a point 10 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb-line of Burbage Road as measured from the north-eastern side of Turney Road;
- (b) BURBAGE ROAD, introduce a banned left turn for any motor vehicle, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles from Burbage Road at its junction with Turney Road from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am – 10 am and 3 pm – 6 pm;
- (c) CALTON AVENUE, introduce a banned left turn for any motor vehicle, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles from Calton Avenue at its junction with Townley Road from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am – 10 am and 3 pm – 6 pm;
- (d) TURNEY ROAD, introduce a banned right turn for any motor vehicle, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles from Turney Road at its junction with Burbage Road from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am – 10 am and 3 pm – 6 pm;
- (e) DULWICH VILLAGE, on both sides convert all waiting restrictions to 'at any time' (double yellow lines) from its junction with East Dulwich Grove/Village Way to (i) its junction with Turney Road on the south-west side, and (ii) and a point 7.5 metres south-east of its junction with Gilkes Place on the north-east side.

These measures are subject to experimental Traffic Management Orders (TMOs). A TMO is the legal mechanism the council, as traffic authority, uses to control aspects of the way that the highway is used. They provide the legal backing to signs and road markings used on the highway and allow them to be enforceable.

The experimental TMOs will be enforceable for a period up to 18 months to allow the assessment of any impact the restrictions might have on the area and surrounding roads, and to revise the


scheme if necessary within that time. A review will be carried out to assess the initial success of the scheme and whether the restrictions should be made permanent.



The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 9 and 10 of Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

#### Citation, commencement and expiry

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Burbage Road area) Experimental Traffic Order 2020, shall come into force on 22 October 2020 and will expire on 25 April 2022.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"bus", "local bus", "pedal cycle", and "taxi" have the meanings given in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>b</sup>;

"bus gate" are each defined for the purposes of this Order in the four sub-categories below:

(i) "the northernmost Burbage Road bus gate" for the purposes of this Order is defined as part of the carriageway of Burbage Road (the north-westbound lane) at the north-western kerb-line of Turney Road;

(ii) "the southernmost Burbage Road bus gate" for the purposes of this Order is defined as part of the carriageway of Burbage Road (the westbound lane) at the north-western kerb-line of Gallery Road;

(iii) "the Dulwich Village bus gate" for the purposes of this Order is defined as part of the carriageway of Dulwich Village (the northbound lane) at the common boundary of Nos. 116 and 118 Dulwich Village;

(iv) "the Turney Road bus gate" for the purposes of this Order is defined as part of the carriageway of Turney Road (the north-eastbound lane) at a point 10 metres of the north-eastern kerb-line of Burbage Road as measured from the north-eastern side of Turney Road;

causing includes permitting;

"carriageway" has the same meaning as in section 329(1) of the Highways Act 1980<sup>c</sup>;

"Dulwich Village roundabout" for the purposes of this Order means the clockwise traffic flow located at the junctions of Burbage Road/College Road/Dulwich Village/Gallery Road;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"kerb-line" means the imaginary line which is the projection of the line formed by the edge of the carriageway of a street;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 185(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988<sup>d</sup> and section 136(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"prohibited hours" means the period from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am - 10 am and 3 pm - 6 pm; and

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

#### Prescribed routes

#### Burbage Road

- 3.1 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in a south-eastern direction in Burbage Road shall, upon reaching its junction with Turney Road, cause that motor vehicle to turn left during the prohibited hours.
- 3.2 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in a north-western direction in that part of Burbage Road which lies south-east of its junction with Turney Road shall, upon reaching its junction with Turney Road, cause that motor vehicle to enter or proceed into the northernmost Burbage Road bus gate (north-west of its junction with Turney Road) during the prohibited hours.
- 3.3 Nothing in Articles 3.1 and 3.2 above shall apply to a bus, local bus, taxi or pedal cycle.

#### Dulwich Village roundabout

- 4.1 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in the Dulwich Village roundabout (from Burbage Road, College Road, Dulwich Village or Gallery Road) shall, upon reaching the Dulwich Village bus gate, cause that motor vehicle to enter and proceed into that bus gate during the prohibited hours.
- 4.2 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in the Dulwich Village roundabout (from Burbage Road, College Road, Dulwich Village or Gallery Road) shall, upon reaching the southernmost Burbage Road bus gate, cause that motor vehicle to enter and proceed into that bus gate during the prohibited hours.
- 4.3 Nothing in Articles 4.1 and 4.2 above shall apply to a bus, local bus, taxi or pedal cycle.

#### Turney Road

- 5.1 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in a north-eastern direction in that part of Turney Road which lies south-west of its junction with Burbage Road shall, upon reaching that junction, cause that motor vehicle to enter and proceed into the northernmost Burbage Road bus gate during the prohibited hours.
- 5.2 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in a north-eastern direction in Turney Road shall cause that motor vehicle to enter and proceed into the Turney Road bus gate during the prohibited hours.

- 5.3 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in a south-western direction in that part of Turney Road which lies north-east of its junction with Burbage Road shall, upon reaching that junction, cause that motor vehicle to turn right during the prohibited hours.
- 5.4 Nothing in Articles 5.1, 5.2 and 5.3 above shall apply to a bus, local bus, taxi or pedal cycle.

#### Exemptions

- 6.1 Nothing in Articles 3, 4 and 5 above shall apply in relation to:-
  - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
  - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
  - (d) any vehicle being used for the purpose of refuse collection, maintenance, improvement, re-construction, cleansing or lighting of that part of street; and
  - (e) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to that part of street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any electronic communications network; or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of street.

#### Power to modify or suspend this Order

7.1 In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Road Network and Parking Business Unit Manager (or such other officer of the council as holds the post of Traffic Manager as defined in section 17 of the Traffic Management Act 2004<sup>e</sup>) may, if it appears to that officer essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend any provision of this Order, save that no modification shall make an addition.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

#### (This note is not part of the Order)

This Order, as part of the London Streetspace Programme – Dulwich phase 2, by way of an experiment:-

- (a) introduces timed bus gates in the following locations, in which only buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles are permitted to enter and proceed during the prohibited hours (i) "the northernmost Burbage Road bus gate" the north-westbound lane of Burbage Road at the north-western kerb-line of Turney Road, (ii) "the southernmost Burbage Road bus gate" the westbound lane of Burbage Road at the north-western kerb-line of Gallery Road, (iii) "the Dulwich Village bus gate" the northbound lane of Dulwich Village at the common boundary of Nos. 116 and 118 Dulwich Village and (iv) "the Turney Road bus gate" the north-eastbound lane of Turney Road at a point 10 metres northeast of the north-eastern kerb-line of Burbage Road as measured from the north-eastern side of Turney Road;
- (b) prohibits any motor vehicles, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles turning left into Turney Road from Burbage Road during the prohibited hours; and
- (c) prohibits any motor vehicles, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles turning right into Burbage Road from Turney Road during the prohibited hours,

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Prescribed routes) (Townley Road area) Experimental Traffic Order 2020, shall come into force on 22 October 2020 and will expire on 25 April 2022.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"bus", "local bus", "pedal cycle", and "taxi" have the meanings given in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>b</sup>;

"bus gate" for the purposes of this Order is defined as part of the carriageway of Townley Road (the north-westbound lane) at the common boundary of Nos. 52 and 53 Townley Road;

causing includes permitting;

"carriageway" has the same meaning as in section 329(1) of the Highways Act 1980<sup>c</sup>;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 185(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988<sup>d</sup> and section 136(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"prohibited hours" means the period from Monday to Friday between the hours of 8 am - 10 am and 3 pm - 6 pm; and

"traffic sign" means a sign of any size, type and colour prescribed and authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

#### Prescribed routes

Calton Avenue

- 3.1 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in a northern direction in Calton Avenue shall, upon reaching its junction with Townley Road, cause that motor vehicle to turn left during the prohibited hours.
- 3.2 Nothing in Article 3.1 above shall apply to a bus, local bus, taxi or pedal cycle.

#### Townley Road

- 4.1 No person causing any motor vehicle to proceed in a north-western direction in Townley Road shall, upon reaching the bus gate, cause that motor vehicle to enter and proceed into that bus gate during the prohibited hours.
- 4.2 Nothing in Article 4.1 above shall apply to a bus, local bus, taxi or pedal cycle.

#### Exemptions

- 5.1 Nothing in Articles 3.1 or 4.1 above shall apply in relation to:-
  - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
  - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
  - (d) any vehicle being used for the purpose of refuse collection, maintenance, improvement, re-construction, cleansing or lighting of that part of street; and
  - (e) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to that part of street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any electronic communications network; or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of street.

#### Power to modify or suspend this Order

6.1 In pursuance of section 10(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Road Network and Parking Business Unit Manager (or such other officer of the council as holds the post of Traffic Manager as defined in section 17 of the Traffic Management Act 2004<sup>e</sup>) may, if it appears to that officer essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by this Order runs, modify or suspend any provision of this Order, save that no modification shall make an addition.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

#### (This note is not part of the Order)

This Order, as part of the London Streetspace Programme – Dulwich phase 2, by way of an experiment:

- (i) introduces a timed bus gate in Townley Road at the common boundary of Nos. 52 and 53 Townley Road (north-westbound part of the carriageway only), in which only buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles are permitted to enter and proceed during the prohibited hours; and
- (ii) prohibits any motor vehicles, except buses, local buses, taxis and pedal cycles turning left into Townley Road from Calton Avenue during the prohibited hours,
