

# **Surrey Quays Road cycle hire station**

- 1. Southwark Council hereby GIVES NOTICE that it proposes to make the above orders under powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>1</sup>, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the orders would be:- in SURREY QUAYS ROAD the south-east side outside Montreal House, to remove a loading only bay 26 metres in length, with a new cycle hire docking station maintained by Transport for London and their agents.





The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup>, as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as The London Borough of Southwark (Loading bays) (No. \*) Order 20\*\* and shall come into force on xx xxxxxxxx 20\*\*.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"the Order of 2016" means the London Borough of Southwark (Loading bays) (No. 1) Order 2016<sup>b</sup>.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2016 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

The council of the London Borough of Southwark, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 6, 45, 49, and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>a</sup> as amended, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:-

#### Citation and commencement

1.1 This Order may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Parking places) (London cycle hire scheme) (Amendment No. \*) Order 20\*\* and shall come into force on xx xxxxx 20\*\*.

#### Interpretation

2.1 In this Order:-

"council" means the council of the London Borough of Southwark;

"cycle docking station parking place" refers to an area of carriageway or footway designated by this Order as a parking place for pedal cycles used for the London cycle hire scheme:

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, bye-law, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment;

"London cycle hire scheme" refers to the pedal cycle rental scheme operated by Transport for London and their agents;

"pedal cycle" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016<sup>b</sup>; and

"the Order of 2009" means the London Borough of Southwark (Parking Places) (London Cycle Hire Scheme) Order 2009<sup>c</sup>.

- 2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.
- 2.3 Unless the context otherwise requires, any expression used in this Order which is also used in the Order of 2009 shall have the same meaning as in that Order.

#### Designation of cycle docking station parking places and application of the Order of 2009 thereto

- 3.1 Each area on a street specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order is designated as a cycle docking station parking place for the leaving only of pedal cycles used for the London Cycle Hire Scheme.
- 3.2 The provisions of the Order of 2009 shall apply to each area described in the Schedule to this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a cycle docking station parking place shall include a reference to each area designated as a cycle docking station parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2009 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

#### Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 4.1 The council shall:-
  - (a) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each cycle docking station parking place referred to in the Schedule, traffic signs indicating that such loading bay may be used for the leaving only of pedal cycles used for the London cycle hire scheme; and
  - (b) carry out such other work as is reasonably required for the purposes of the satisfactory operation of a cycle docking station parking place.

## (Areas of carriageway designated as 'cycle docking station' parking places)

SURREY QUAYS ROAD
the south-east side, from a point 38 metres south-west of a point opposite the south-western kerb-line of Needleman Street, south-westward for a distance of 26 metres, having a width throughout of 2 metres.
