Works update

We have now completed phase 1 of the external drainage works. Scaffolding for the entire frame continues to be erected and is now approximately 70% complete. External cladding on the frame has also now started.

We will be commencing some demolition and piling works this month to start off the second phase of the project. We apologise in advance for the noisy works that will resume.
