ENGIE is working in part nership with Southwark Council to build new council homes at Meeting House Lane.

Strong foundations laid...

Under Phase 2 of our works we have poured the ground floor and first floor concrete slab and are currently pouring the slab for the second floor.

We are currently continuing with brickwork to the external structure and have started installing the balcony doors.

To ensure we mitigate some of the delay caused by the COVID-19 lockdown and the need to maintain social distancing on site, we have been granted extended working hours (8am - 7pm, Monday to Friday and 8am - 5pm, Saturdays) by Southwark Council's Environmental Protection Team.

We will only carry out works in the extended period when it is critically required and benefits the completion of the development.

We will try to minimise noise during late working periods and substitute percussive tools for quieter alternatives.
