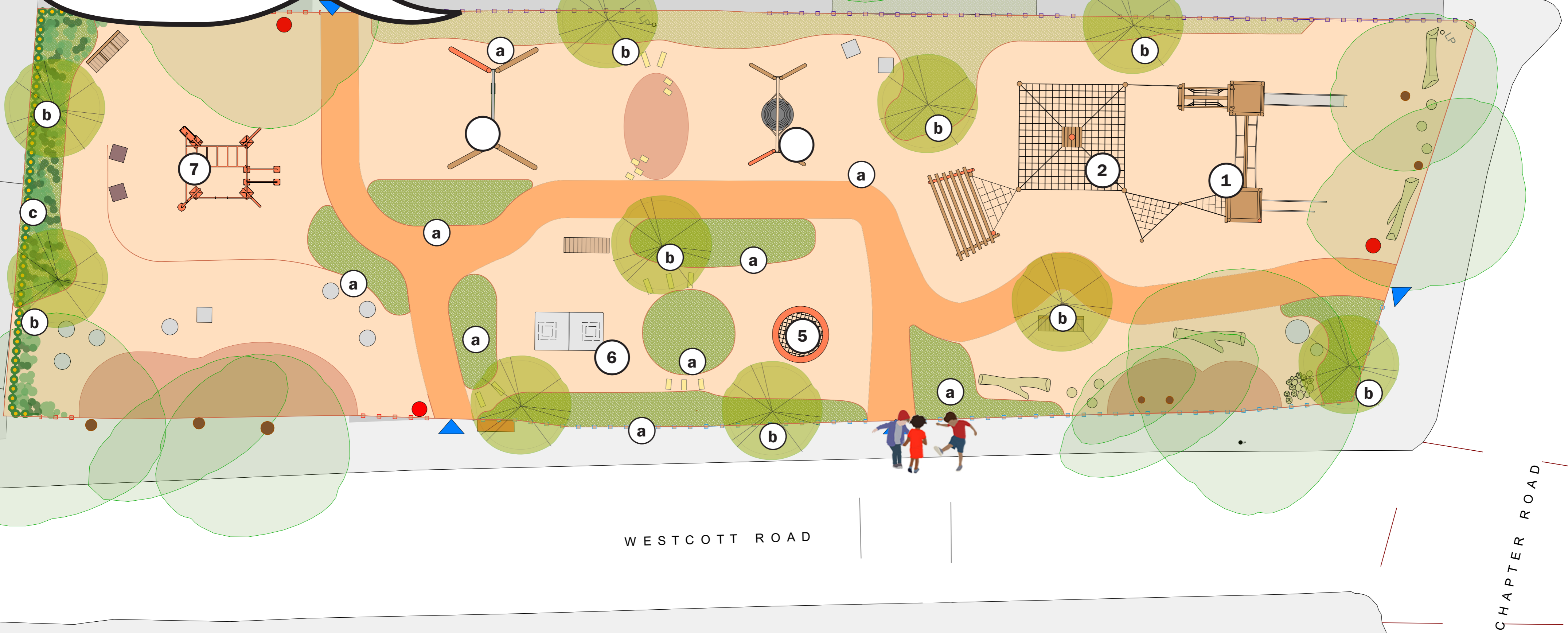


FREDERICKS PLAYGROUND

Main play structure

A hybrid of two play structures, that are combined to offer a variety of routes and challenge.

- 1 Towers and slides- Seeburg unit



- 2 Net Climbing- Brocken unit



Material

Robinia wood structure (handful of the structural elements to be finished in the accent colour)



Play Equipment

Constructed from a mixture of robinia timber and steel with elements in PPC finish (accent colour).

- 5 Trampoline



- 6 Table Tennis Table



Fitness Equipment

The proposal will have a large callisthenics fitness unit in the south of the site.

Look and Feel

Accent colour pops throughout the site to create sophisticated and graphical visual impact.



Continuous rail - A steel rail will form the boundary around the site (finish- accent colour). The rail will curve up to form the trellis at the south of the site.



Planting

A diverse and unusual planting pallet will pique interest and improve biodiversity.

Trellis- a PPC steel rail will also form the structure for a trellis in the south of the site. This will hold a metal net and be planted with star jasmine
