The residents of the Tustin Estate have voted for the demolition and rebuild of Bowness House, Heversham House, Hillbeck Close and Kentmere House, and the refurbishment of the council houses on Manor Grove. The first phase of new homes are now being built and will be ready in 2025

Electric cookers

At the Resident Project Group on 9
November 2023 it was agreed that all new homes, including the refurbished council homes in Manor Grove, will be provided with a new electric cooker worth over £500 (Hotpoint HDM67V9HCX/UK or equivalent). This is instead of providing a £400 grant to each resident, as this provides better value for residents.
