- (a) BRISBANE STREET in CPZ 'EC' north-west side, reduce permit (i) o/s Hood House, Brisbane Street (68m remain) and (ii) side of No. 34 Picton Street (10.5m remain);
- (b) CALTON AVENUE east side o/s St Barnabas Church, add two new 'limited stay' disabled bays 6.6m each in length in which vehicles displaying a valid disabled persons 'blue badge' are permitted to stay on Sundays only between 7am – 7pm (max stay 2hrs, no return within 2hrs);
- (c) CHANCEL STREET in CPZ 'C1' north-east side, introduce 40m 'shared-use' between its junctions with Burrell Street and Treveris Street:
- (d) CONSORT ROAD north-east side, extend and formalise existing mandatory with-flow cycle lane between its junctions with Nunhead Lane and Scylla Road:

- (h) PECKHAM GROVE in PZ 'R', reduce existing permit (i) south-west side, o/s No. 44 Peckham Grove (12.5m remains) and ii) north-east side, south of junction with Blakes Road (36.5m remain);
- REVERDY ROAD in PZ 'TS' west side, side of No. 143 Fort Road, split and reduce existing permit (36m total remain);
- WEBBER ROW south-east side, introduce 15m solo motorcycle parking opposite No. 56 Webber Row;
- (k) add new or amend existing waiting restrictions to 'at any time' double yellow lines (DYLs) unless otherwise stated, in the following locations: BONAR ROAD south-west side 8m at its junction with Commercial Way, BOYFIELD STREET full length, BRISBANE STREET north-east side 4m o/s Hood House, CHANCEL STREET convert single yellow lines (SYL) to DYLs between Burrell Street and Treveris Street (12m total), COMMERCIAL WAY south-east side (i) extend across its junction with Furley Road (43m total) and (ii) extend between its junctions with Bonar Road and Sumner Road (170m), CONSORT ROAD (i) north-east side between its junctions with Nunhead Lane and Scylla Road (83m) and (ii) south-west side o/s Nos. 282 - 284 (37m), DAVIDGE STREET both sides at its junction with Library Street 7.5m per side, DULWICH WOOD AVENUE north-east side (i) across its junction with Rusholme Grove (23m) and (ii) o/s Oakfield Gardens (20m), FURLEY ROAD both sides at its junction with Commercial Way 5m per side, GAINSFORD STREET (i) south-west between its junctions with

The general effect of the cycle tracks order, in conjunction with the powers conferred by section 65(1) of the Highways Act 1980³, would be:- to formalise a one-way south-westbound segregated cycle track for the use of pedal cycles only in the area of footpath south-west of the junction of FORESTER ROAD and TRESCO ROAD.
- 4. Southwark Council hereby GIVES FURTHER NOTICE under sections 90A to 90I of the Highways Act 1980 and in accordance with the provisions of the Highways (Road humps) Regulations 1999⁴ and the Highways (Traffic calming) Regulations 1999⁵, place new road humps of sinusoidal cross-section construction, approx. 3.7m in length, having a maximum height of 100 millimetres and covering the greater width of the carriageway, centred at each point, at the following locations:-BOYFIELD STREET (i) 22.5m south-east of its junction with Webber Street, (ii) 13m north-west of the south-eastern wall of Albury Buildings, and (iii) 35m north-west of its junction with King James Street; and SILEX STREET (i) 43m south-east of its junction with Webber Street, (ii) 42m north-west of its junction with King James Street.

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A minor traffic scheme (or non-strategic traffic and highway improvement) is a small project where the council proposes to modify the existing Highway layout. This may include changes to waiting and loading restrictions, parking places etc.

Note: 'DYLs' refer to double yellow lines ('at any time' waiting restrictions) and 'SYL' refer to single yellow lines; 'permit' refers to parking places for holders of valid parking permits within the Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ/PZ) listed; and 'shared-use' refer to parking places in which holders of a valid permit for the CPZ/PZ listed or paid ticket holders are permitted to park within the permitted hours. All measurements are in metres 'm' and are approximate. Parking charges are listed on www.southwark.gov.uk/parking

2.2 Any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment.

Cycle lane

- 3.1 No person shall cause any vehicle other than a pedal cycle to enter into or proceed in the cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Order at any time.
- 3.2 Every person causing a pedal cycle to enter into the cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Order shall thereupon cause that vehicle to proceed in the direction specified in column (3) of that item.

Exemptions

- 4.1 Nothing in Articles 3.1 or 3.2 above shall apply in relation to:-
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
 - (c) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to a prescribed street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any electronic communications network; or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of that street; or
 - (d) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
- 4.2 Nothing in Article 3.1 above shall apply in relation to any vehicle entering into the cycle lane specified in the Schedule to this Order for as long as necessary:-
 - to enable access to or exit from premises adjoining that cycle lane by way of a vehicular access or footway crossover, provided that vehicle leaves the cycle lane immediately thereafter;
 - (b) to enable access to or exit from a lay-by adjoining the cycle lane, provided that vehicle leaves the cycle lane immediately thereafter:
 - (c) to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle; or
 - (d) to enable goods to be loaded on to or unloaded from the vehicle, if and in so far as the activity is not prohibited by the provisions of any other Order; or
 - (e) for the purpose of collecting refuse; or
 - (f) for the purposes of the provision of a universal postal service, provided the vehicle bears the livery of a universal postal service provider.

- 4.2 The provisions of the Order of 2018 (other than Articles 3, 16 and 17) shall apply to each area designated as a parking place by this Order as if in those provisions any reference to a designated parking place or to a parking place shall include a reference to the area designated as a parking place by this Order and as if any reference to Schedule 1 to the Order of 2018 included a reference to the Schedule to this Order.

Placing of traffic signs etc.

- 5.1 The council shall:-
 - (a) place and maintain traffic signs indicating the limits of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) place and maintain in or in the vicinity of each parking place referred to in the Schedule to this Order traffic signs indicating that such a parking place may be used during the permitted hours for the leaving only of the vehicles specified in Articles 4.1 and 4.2 of the Order of 2018; and

Prescribed routes

Barforth Road

- 3.1 Every person causing any vehicle to proceed in a south-eastern direction in Barforth Road shall, upon reaching its junction with Forester Road, cause that vehicle to turn left.
- 3.2 Nothing in Article 3.1 above shall apply to a pedal cycle.

Forester Road

- 4.1 No person causing any vehicle to proceed in that part of Forester Road, which lies between the north-eastern kerb-line of Carden Road and a point 5 metres south-west of the south-western kerb-line of Tresco Road, shall cause that vehicle to proceed in any direction other than from south-west to north-east.
- 4.2 No person causing any vehicle to proceed in the Forester Road and Tresco Road junction area, shall cause that vehicle to proceed in any direction other than from south-west to north-east, except for pedal cycles using the Forester Road and Tresco Road pedal cycle gap.
- 4.3 No person causing any vehicle to proceed in that part of Forester Road, which lies between the south-western kerb-line of Tresco Road and its junction with Linden Grove, shall cause that vehicle to proceed in any direction other than from south-west to north-east.
- 4.4 Nothing in Article 4.1 and 4.3 above shall apply to a pedal cycle.

Linden Grove

- 5.1 No person causing any vehicle to proceed in Linden Grove shall, upon reaching its junction with Forester Road cause that vehicle to enter into Forester Road.
- 5.2 Nothing in Article 5.1 above shall apply to a pedal cycle.

Tresco Road

- 6.1 Every person causing any vehicle to proceed in a north-western direction in Tresco Road shall, upon reaching its junction with Forester Road, cause that vehicle to turn right.
- 6.2 No person causing any vehicle to proceed in Tresco Road shall, upon reaching its junction with Forester Road cause that vehicle to enter into the Forester Road and Tresco Road junction area, except for pedal cycles using the Forester Road and Tresco Road pedal cycle gap.
- 6.3 Nothing in Article 6.1 above shall apply to a pedal cycle.

Exemptions

- 7.1 Nothing in Articles 3, 4, 5 and 6 above shall apply in relation to:-
 - (a) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed on the highway pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicle being used for the maintenance, improvement, re-construction, refuse collection, cleansing or lighting of that part of street; and
 - (e) any vehicle being used in connection with the laying, erection, alteration, or repair in or adjacent to that part of street of any sewer, main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity, or of any electronic communications network; or the placing, maintenance or removal of any traffic sign, if the vehicle cannot be used for that purpose in any other street or part of street.
