

Examination of the New Southwark Plan
Notice of Independent Examination Hearings
Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012
Statutory Instrument No.767 Regulation 24

The New Southwark Plan 2013-2033 was submitted by the Council of the London Borough of Southwark to the Secretary of State for examination on 16 January 2020. David Spencer BA (Hon) DipTP MRTPI and Philip Mileham BA(Hons) MA MRTPI, are the inspectors appointed to carry out the independent examination into the legal compliance and soundness of the New Southwark Plan and subsequently issue a report with their conclusions. As part of the independent examination, they will hold a number of public hearing sessions.

Due to the ongoing coronavirus pandemic, the hearing sessions will be held as a "virtual event". This will involve the Inspectors, Council officers and invited participants being heard "virtually" through the use of video conferencing or phone. This will use the "Zoom" video conferencing system. Only those involved directly within the virtual hearing sessions will be invited to the relevant "Zoom" sessions. The hearing sessions will be live streamed on the Council's YouTube channel and recordings made available for any interested parties to view for up to 3 months after the date of the hearing.

The virtual Examination Hearings will commence at 10:00am on Tuesday 23 February 2021.
