### Project Update

The steel frame is now complete and the floor slab metal decking is being installed ready for concrete works to start at the end of this month.

Scaffold erection to the floor levels has started with the rear elevation completed to full height ready for the materials hoist installation to begin which will allow bricks and blocks to be loaded out across the floors and the walls to start being built.



### Upcoming Events and On-site Activities

26/10/20 - Commence the loading out and installing of the metal floor pans and concrete floor slabs—6 weeks  
 30/11/20 - Blockwork internal walls starting to be built from the ground floor upwards including forming the lift shaft and stair core  
 04/01/21—Commencement of the face brickwork to all external walls

To date all of the waste produced on site has been able to be recycled by Advanced Waste Solutions giving a 100% green rating for site waste on this project.

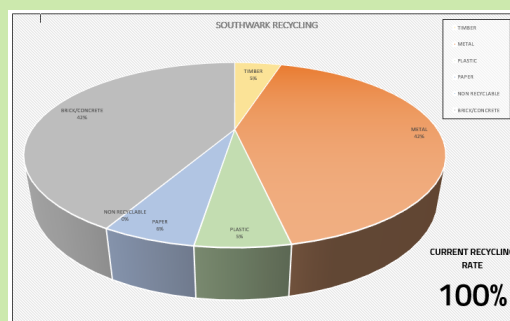
TIMBER = 5%
