What are we Building?

We are delighted to have been appointed by The London Borough of Southwark to undertake the works at Sedgmoor Place. The works comprise the demolition of the existing Hostel building on Sedgmoor Place and the construction of 13 new flats and maisonettes for social rent. The structure will be a traditional brick finish and is a mix of 2 and 4 storey height. Works are anticipated to start from January 2021 and complete in June 2022.

Works will comprise of the following:

- Demolition January 2021
- Substructure February 2021 May 2021
- Superstructure June 2021 October 2021
- Roof works October 2021 November 2021
- Internal Works December 2021 March 2022
- External works April 2022 July 2022

In order to facilitate the works, we will be suspending the parking bays along Sedgmoor Place that are alongside

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
