



1-27 RODNEY PLACE, SE17

We aim to build nine new council homes at 1-27 Rodney Place, SE17 as part of our commitment to providing more quality council homes across the borough.

We are committed to delivering 11,000 new council homes by 2043 – a big goal but crucial if we're going to tackle the housing crisis and ensure that our residents have homes they can be proud of, now and in the future.

At least 50% of these new homes will be let to tenants in the local area and the remainder allocated to households on our wider housing waiting list.

Our Proposal

The image on the right above shows the proposed new development at Rodney Place.

We propose to build a 4 storey building to accommodate 9 new one and two bedroom homes with a commercial space on the ground floor.
