#### **Our current progress**


- Scaffold has been erected around phase 2 of the building with brickworks ongoing
- First fix mechanical and electrical works are still underway but have been completed on the first and second levels
- Thames Water have finished with their part of the drainage system
- District heating supply pipes have now been installed and connected to the building

#### **Coming next**

• New kitchens and bathrooms are due to start being installed over the coming weeks as well as new front doors.

To ensure we mitigate delays caused by the COVID-19 lockdown and to maintain social distancing on site, we have been granted extended working hours (8am - 7pm, Monday to Friday and 8am - 5pm, Saturdays) by Southwark Council's Environmental Protection Team.

We will only carry out works in the extended period when it is critically required and benefits the completion of the development.



# COVID-19 measures

The Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic remains a real danger to members of the public as such, we continue to take measures to prevent the spread of infection whilst we undertake our works.

Measures we've implemented on this site include a security marshal at the site's entry gate to sign staff in and ask guestions about their health, a number of hand washing and sanitising stations, reduced workforce on site, a one way system, a dedicated cleaner to clean and sanitise site office facilities throughout each day, and reduced numbers of staff allowed within the welfare areas to ensure social distancing.

Our operatives have also received specific training on how to undertake the works during this pandemic, ensuring their safety as well as that of residents and members of the general public.
