ENGIE has been appointed by Southwark Council to build 23 new council homes at Rye Hill Park.

Working in partnership with Southwark Council, we will be demolishing the existing garages to create 23 council rent homes within two medium rise blocks with interjoining open walkways and landscaped communal areas.

This is the first of regular newsletters you will be receiving from us throughout the duration of this scheme. In each issue we will provide a general update on our progress, contact details for your ENGIE site team and important reminders.


The good news is that we are due to commence works this month. The initial site presence will be in the form of securing the site boundary with hoarding followed by ground surveys, demolition of the existing garages, and the establishment of our site offices and welfare accommodation.

Work to preserve the existing trees has already begun with the pruing of overhanging brances to guard them from possible damage. Further three protection measures will be in place throughout the scheme.
