

Dear Residents,

Proposed New Homes at the old NHS Building at 1 Ann Moss Way – Soil Survey

I'm writing to let you know that planned soil survey investigations will be carried out on the old NHS building at 1 Ann Moss Way. The works will commence on Tuesday 16th February to Thursday 18th February between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm.

In order to complete the survey there will be no changes to the current parking arrangements on the access road that leads to the old NHS building. The soil survey works are estimated to take between one and three days. Please refer to the site map below:



There will be no access within the red line boundary for vehicles or pedestrians and the parking bays marked in pink will be suspended. The blue crosses indicates the works that will be carried out which will cause an obstruction.

We aim to get these works completed as quickly as possible to minimise any inconvenience.

The purpose of the soil survey is to ensure we obtain information to assist us with the design development of the new buildings.

The works will involve drilling boreholes for the purpose of collecting environmental soil samples and undertaking ground gas and groundwater monitoring.

Unfortunately the works will create some noise whilst the holes are drilled. When each borehole is completed it will be carefully backfilled. Every effort will be made to reinstate the ground to a suitable standard once works have ceased.

We apologise in advance that these works will likely cause some disturbances or inconvenience to anyone that uses the parking bays which are indicated in pink at the top of this letter.

Please Note:

Cars will be removed if there are parked within the bays which are indicated in pink at the top of this letter on Tuesday 16th February to Thursday 18th February between 8:00 am and 6:00 pm.
