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PUBLIC NOTICE SOUTHWARK COUNCIL

In accordance with the Local Authorities (Members Allowances) (England) Regulations 2003, Southwark Council is publishing details of the allowances paid to Councillors for the financial year 1 April 2007-31March 2008, along with details of the allowances scheme which applied.

The Members' Allowances Scheme 2007-2010 was agreed by council in May and June 2007. The scheme makes provision for a basic allowance to be paid to all members, and for special responsibility allowances (SRAs) to be paid to members who take on significant additional responsibilities. The allowances are grouped in bands, and the amounts for each band are set out below. The scheme provides for index-linked increases until June 2010 in line with the Local Government Pay Settlement for officers. No member may receive more than one SRA but with effect from June 2007 members of the licensing committee are paid £117 per meeting to recognise the heavy additional workload of the Licensing Committee.

Band 3 and 4 allowances are dependant on the number of hours per week the

- member is employed elsewhere, as set out below: - less than 11 hours elsewhere, full SRA
 - 11-24 hours elsewhere, two thirds SRA
 - more than 24 hours elsewhere, one third SRA.

Band 1a allowance - payable to the Chair of audit committee; Deputy leader majority opposition; Leader of minority opposition; Opposition group whip;

Independent chair of standards committee. Band 1b allowance - payable to Deputy mayor; Vice chair of overview & scruti-

ny; Chairs of community councils (x8); Chair of disciplinary appeals. Band 2a allowance - payable to Chairs of scrutiny sub-committees; Chair of planning committee; Chair of licensing committee; Chief whip; Leader of majority opposition.

Band 2b allowance - payable to the Mayor.
Band 3 Allowance - payable to the Deputy leader, members of the Executive (x8), and to the Chair of overview and scrutiny

Band 4 Allowance - payable to the Leader of the Council.

The chair of standards committee should receive a band 1 allowance but no other allowances. Statutory co-opted Members of Standards and Education Committees receive an annual allowance of £1,061, but do not receive the basic allowance.

The full scheme also allows members and statutory co-opted members to claim travelling and subsistence allowance when on Council business outside the borough. Members with disabilities may claim transport costs within the borough. Members may also claim for taxi fares for journeys after 9pm BST and 7pm GMT.

Non statutory co-optees who do not receive an allowance can claim reimbursement for travel and subsistence. Members and statutory & non statutory co-opted members are entitled to claim dependent carer's allowance in connection with eligible meetings. At present a pension scheme for members is not in operation.

London Councils' recommendations

The Allowances were set following consideration by the Council's Standards Committee, and consideration of reports by an Independent Panel constituted by The main features of the Independent Panel's 2003 report

- The amount of Basic Allowance should remain as recommended in the last report as £8,500, but uprated for subsequent increases in the cost of living by reference to the appropriate index, which in 2003 led to a figure of £9,149.40.
- Special Responsibility Allowances should continue to be paid in respect of the responsibilities specified in the previous report, and on the basis of the bands and the ranges of allowances within each band, recommended in their previous report, uprated for subsequent increases in the cost of living by reference to an appropriate index.
- The index used to uprate allowances should be the Local Government Pay Settlement for Officers, and that this index should apply for the next four
- years (until June 2010). This equates to a figure of £10,213 for 2007/2008. The following figures show the ranges for SRAs (exclusive of the Basic

Allowance) recommended by the ALG in 2003. Band 1 - £2,694.56 - £8,291.84 Band 2 - £13,889.12-£25,083.68

Band 3 - £30,680.96-£36,232.40

Band 4 - £47,472.80

- The Basic Allowance should be treated as covering all intra-Borough travel costs and subsistence, but with local variations.
- Where travel and subsistence allowances are payable, they should be in accordance for the current scheme applicable for the Borough's officers. Travel allowances should extend to travel by bicycles.
- An Annual Allowance for co-optees should be calculated by reference to the estimated number of meetings per year, calculated at £100 per meeting. Cooptees should be reimbursed for all travel costs, whether in or outside the bor-
- ough, but should not be paid subsistence. • Dependants' carers' allowances should be payable, and a flexible approach is recommended. In particular boroughs should have regard to local social serv-
- ices departments' levels of reimbursement. All Members under the age of 70 should in principle be entitled to apply for
- inclusion in a pension scheme, without satisfying any period of qualification. • Both basic and special responsibility allowances should be pensionable.

There are 63 elected members of the council. The following table includes all elected members at the beginning of and during the year as well as appointed independent and co-opted members.
