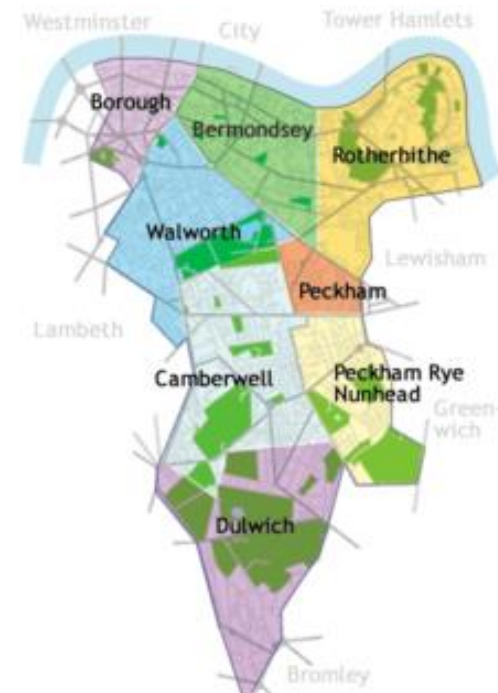
Southwark



Southwark stretches from the internationally renowned cultural quarter along the South Bank of the Thames at its north end, with more urban Bermondsey, Peckham and Camberwell at its centre down to leafy Dulwich at its Southern tip. It incorporates 5 major parks and open spaces suitable for and large scale events.

With the highest proportion of 25-40 year olds living in London, Southwark is the youngest and arguably most vibrant place in the city.

Southwark is an inspiring, progressive and entrepreneurial borough. It's home to many of London's most iconic attractions including London Bridge, The Shard, Tate Modern, Shakespeare's Globe, Borough Market, Imperial War Museum, Dulwich Picture Gallery and new cultural hub Peckham and Bermondsey.



Burgess Park



Located 10-15 mins walk from Oval, Kennington and Elephant and Castle Underground Stations Burgess Park is the perfect location to hold large scale commercial and festival events.

Nestled between Camberwell, Walworth, Bermondsey and Peckham Burgess Park covers over 560,000sqm of open park land.

After receiving a £8million restoration grant, the new Burgess Park is regularly packed with locals taking advantage of the facilities and enjoying a BBQ.

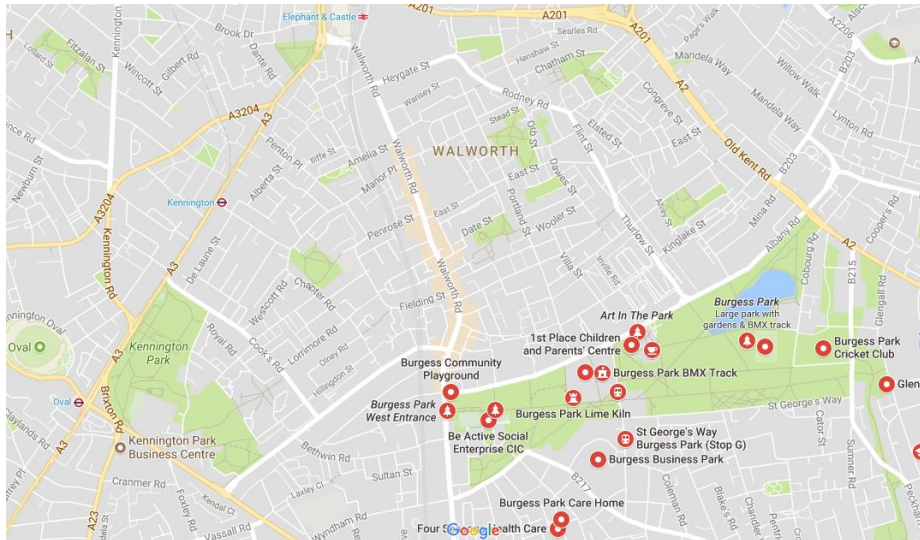
