Fenwick Road pre-planning proposal

We write to you today regarding our proposal for building new council homes at 55-77 Fenwick Road, which are:

- To build eight new homes for council rent with private amenity spaces in a three and four-storey pitched roof block
- To improve the rear of the garden in the adjacent block for existing and new residents

As you may be aware, we have been working with a group of local residents to develop the designs for new council homes on the estate and to improve the communal garden.

We held an open event in October 2020, and have subsequently held three Resident Project Group meetings to enable residents to share their views and shape the designs. We will be holding another Resident Project Group meeting in the next few weeks. We also held a survey to listen to your ideas on how we can improve the communal garden on the estate.

During this time the designs for the development evolved in line with contributions and ideas from residents. We are pleased with the latest design proposals which incorporate the feedback we received from the local community.

At this stage in our process, we would usually invite you to attend a drop-in event to see the completed designs before we submit the planning application. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic and social distancing restrictions, we will instead be publishing the proposal boards online here: <u>https://fenwickroad.commonplace.is/</u>
