

Accessible housing Register

The accessible housing register is a nationwide standard that indicates the level of accessibility of a property.

Households can bid "up" so that if you are an E+ you can bid for a B, and B categories can bid for E+ homes.

Wheelchair accessible throughout - Designed to meet the latest accessible housing design standards offering extra space and full access to all rooms and facilities. Stepfree entry. If above the ground floor there will be at least 2 lifts. If there are any internal stairs, a through-floor lift or platform stair-lift will be in place as well. Kitchen and bathroom will have space for a wheelchair to turn around.

Wheelchair accessible essential rooms - Designed to older wheelchair standards or significantly adapted to provide extra space and wheelchair access to the essential facilities of the property (that is, a bedroom, bathroom, toilet, living room and kitchen). Other rooms in the house such as additional bedrooms or bathrooms may not be wheelchair accessible. Step-free entry.
