ORDER (No. 4) 2017

Made this 22nd day of November 2017

The London Borough of Southwark ("the Council") makes this Order in exercise of its powers under Section 247 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended) ("the Act") and all other enabling powers.

1. The Council authorises the stopping up of the areas of highway described in the Schedule to this Order and shown hatched black on the plan attached hereto.
2. This Order is made to enable development to be carried out in accordance with the planning permission granted by the Council on 30 November 2016 under local planning authority reference number No. 16/AP/3165 for:-

'Re-landscaping the South-West region of Burgess Park including a new play area, new access pathways, new lighting fixtures, new surfaces, trees, shrubs, meadow and to include new park furniture.'

3. This Order shall come into force on the date on which notice that it has been made is first published in accordance with Section 252 (10) of the Act, and may be cited as the London Borough of Southwark (Addington Square) Stopping Up Order (No. 4) 2017.

1. *An area of highway in the south eastern corner of Addington Square measuring 13.18m in length from the dead end of Addington Square to the north of Burgess Park and up to 12.12m in width.*

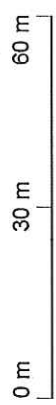
All of the areas to be stopped up fall within the London Borough of Southwark
