

Southwark Council's Licensing Team uses your personal data to process all applications submitted under the Animal Welfare (Licensing of Activities Involving Animals) (England) Regulations 2018, Dangerous Wild Animals Act 1976 and Performing Animals Act 1925. Animal Welfare Licences requires us to keep a register of all applications.

Your personal data will be retained by the Council for as long as the Animal Welfare Licences requires a register and after that for a period of 6 years.

Sometimes we have give to your information to other authorities, organisations or people. This would be for legal matters, for example, the prevention or detection of crime, including fraud. We don't need your consent to do this.
