Notes:-

- For background documentation to the following decisions please refer to the agenda and supporting papers (copies of which are available on the council's website www.southwark.gov.uk or from the constitutional team).
- The overview & scrutiny committee may "call-in" a community council decision which relates to an executive function. This enables the overview and scrutiny committee to consider whether the decision is appropriate. The committee may recommend that the decision is reconsidered or if the decision is outside of the policy and budget framework, refer the matter to the council assembly.
- Decisions not called in by the date specified above will become effectively immediately after the deadline has expired.
- Requests for call-in should normally only be made if there is evidence that the community council did not take the decision in accordance with the principles of decision making as set out in the constitution - Article 1.3.
- Call-in can be requested by any three members of the overview and scrutiny committee
- The request to call-in should give reasons for the call-in and set out any alternative course of action proposed. In particular, the request must state whether or not members believe that the decision is outside the policy or budget framework.
- A copy of the request should be sent to Shelley Burke, head of overview and scrutiny.
- Please note that a member serving on a community council (who is also a member of the overview and scrutiny committee) who participates in taking a decision relating to an executive function shall not sign a call-in request on the same decision (thus avoiding any conflict of interests)
