Name	Role
Harpreet Aujla	Harpreet Aujla is a planning solicitor at Southwark Law Centre. She now advises people in the local community about planning, including planning policy consultations and how to engage with planning application processes so important rights of participation can be effectively engaged and realised. She has advised displaced traders from the Elephant and Castle shopping centre, as well as residents and community groups so they can engage with the process of the local plan development. She has also supported residents in areas of significant development in the borough such as the Old Kent Road area and on Southwark's housing estates.
Rachel Butler	Area Education Communications and Outreach Manager for Veolia and part of the Senior Leadership team at Veolia Southwark. Principally responsible for driving the strategic direction of resident communication and behaviour change campaigns in the borough to improve the recycling rate, as well as supporting our technical teams to deliver on carbon net zero plans, including fleet electrification, and site biodiversity.
Cllr Helen Dennis	Cllr Helen Dennis is Cabinet Member for the Climate Emergency and Sustainable Development at Southwark Council, and Labour councillor for Chaucer Ward. She was appointed to her Cabinet role in May 2021, having held a number of other roles across the council, including a year as Chair of the Housing & Environment Scrutiny Commission. Before her appointment to Cabinet, she worked on climate change and sustainable development for a number of international NGOs and is a member of SERA, Labour's environment campaign.
Prof Obas Ebohon	Obas John Ebohon is Professor of Sustainability and Environmental Law in the School of Built Environment and Architecture and Director of the Centre for Sustainability and Resilient Communities at London Southbank University (LSBU). His research interests include energy, climate change impacts on the built and natural environment, and sustainable community development. He is a consultant and he currently sits on the International Advisory Board of UN-Habitat for the 2020 World City Report (WCR) - Sustainable Urbanisation: Inclusive Prosperity and Opportunity for All.
Aaron Gillich	Dr Aaron Gillich is an Associate Professor of Energy and Building Systems Engineering and Director of the Building Services Research & Innovation Association (BSRIA) at London Southbank University (LSBU) Net Zero Building Centre. Aaron has worked across industry,

	academia, and government. Aaron's research centres on the links between technical and policy solutions to decarbonising existing buildings. He has led a number of research and demonstration projects for low carbon innovations in heat pumps and heat networks. His interests also include retrofit programme design and market transformation strategy.

Helen Hayes MP	Helen Hayes is a British Labour Party politician, who has been the Member of Parliament for Dulwich and West Norwood since the May 2015 general election. Before becoming an MP, she worked as a town planner, and she is committed to involving local people in decision making in all the work that she does.
Karrim Jalali	Karrim has actively campaigned with Fossil Free Southwark since 2016. Fossil Free Southwark initially focussed its campaign on Southwark Council to divest its pension fund from fossil fuel companies. However, in recent years, it has broadened its focus to campaigning and promoting the curbing of greenhouse gas emissions in the borough, as well as ending our unhealthy reliance on fossil fuels.
Jack Lewis	Jack Lewis is the Campaign and Research Officer at the Southwark Group of Tenants Organisation (SGTO). The SGTO is an independent voluntary organisation representing and promoting the rights of tenants and residents groups in Southwark. Jack supports the SGTO's campaigning activity and research work.
Miles Lewis	Miles works for Lendlease, a multinational construction, property and infrastructure company, where he heads up sustainability at the Development and Investment Management businesses in Europe. Miles is also responsible for leading the development and delivery of Lendlease Europe's Roadmap to Absolute Zero Carbon and climate action approach, which will transition the business towards becoming a zero carbon organisation. Miles holds a BSc in Environmental Geography and International Development from the University of East Anglia, one of the main centres for UK climate science.
