The face to face service follows social distancing guidelines and best practice. The Citizens Advice team encourage people to drop in anytime during the opening hours but to avoid early mornings in case of queues.

Bromyard House training

Forest Hill Fire Station will be using Bromyard House for training on Thursday 22 January 2022.

They will be there between 12.30pm and 4.30pm with 4 Fire engines and a command unit.

Housing update

All residents in the tower blocks will have to leave their homes while their blocks are demolished and the new homes are built. All permanent tenants have the right to return to the estate.

Please note that properties are not allocated according to the time you bid. They are allocated by our colleagues in the allocations team according to Southwark Council's lettings policies. Ledbury Towers permanent tenants are in Band One, and the properties are allocated by how many stars each applicant has, then by application date and finally by your tenancy date.

If you need help with bidding or you think your application can attract stars because you or someone else in your household is working or carrying out voluntary work for more than 16 hours a week, do not forget to come in and see the Ledbury Team for help.

We have 184 permanent empty homes as many tenanted households have moved into new homes, and 16 leaseholders sold their properties back to the council. Of course those tenants who have moved retain the right to return.

207 properties were initially refused by tenants who had viewings. However many of these have already received further offers and many residents have already moved into their new homes. No permanent tenant from the Ledbury Towers will be suspended from bidding if they choose to refuse a property.

Warning about bottled gas

It remains vitally important residents do not bring any bottled gas or gas appliances into the tower blocks as we have been advised that the buildings will not withstand the force of a gas explosion.

Fire wardens will also be monitoring to check that no gas canisters are brought into the buildings.

COVID-19 update

COVID-19 rates in Southwark are extremely high so everyone should remain cautious and follow the latest advice.

- Wash hands regularly and wear face coverings in public places including shops, public transport, community centres and faith premises.
- Meet family and friends in wellventilated areas where possible, such as outdoors or indoors with windows open. You are at a higher risk if you are in an enclosed or crowded space, or there is limited fresh air.
- Download the NHS COVID-19 app. Keep your Bluetooth and contact tracing on to stay informed in case you come into contact with a positive case.

England is still in Plan B of the COVID-19 response:

- face coverings are required by law in indoor places such as shops and on public transport and other more public settings, including theatres and cinemas, unless you are exempt
- you should work from home where possible
- people who are fully vaccinated who have had close contact with someone with COVID-19 can take daily lateral flow tests for seven days, instead of selfisolating (if you're not fully vaccinated, have symptoms or test positive you still need to selfisolate)
- <u>the NHS COVID Pass is needed</u> <u>in some venues</u>, including nightclubs. People will be able to demonstrate proof of full vaccination via the app. Proof of a negative lateral flow test will also be accepted.

Get your COVID-19 vaccination

Over 197,000 people registered with a Southwark GP have received a first dose of the vaccine. You can:

- Book online using the NHS national booking service or call 119 free of charge (ages 12 and above)
- Contact your GP (ages 12 and above)
- Use a walk-in clinic in Southwark if you are 12 or over
- Take part in the school-based vaccination programme (ages 12 to 15)

Booster vaccinations

If you have had your second dose at least three months ago, you can have <u>a</u> <u>booster jab if you are</u>:

- Living in a residential care home for older adults
- Aged 18 or over
- A frontline health and social care worker
- Living or working in a care home
- Aged 16 or over with underlying health conditions that put you at higher risk of severe COVID-19
- Aged 16 or over and are a main carer for someone at high risk
- Aged 16 or over and live with someone more likely to get infections (such as someone with cancer or HIV)
- Pregnant and in one of the eligible groups above.

Take a lateral flow test at a community testing site

Take a rapid lateral flow test before meeting with family and friends or going to busy public places. Our testing sites at London Bridge station (St Thomas Street Exit) and 21-23 Bournemouth Road, Peckham have capacity and tests available. You can also order tests to be delivered to your home, or pick them up from a library or some pharmacies. Find out more at:

PCR tests end if you don't have symptoms

If you **don't** have COVID-19 symptoms you no longer need a PCR test to confirm a positive lateral flow. You must still self-isolate for up to 10 days, but can end quarantine if you get two negative lateral flow test results, 24 hours apart, on days six and seven. If you have symptoms you must still get a PCR test. Register the result of your lateral flow test whether it's negative or positive.

Free tests if you have symptoms

It's essential that you get a PCR test as soon as possible if you have any of

these symptoms:

- a high temperature
- a new, continuous cough
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste


