Public meeting for residents & businesses

Last month we told you that we want to talk with residents on how we can improve your homes and make the wider estate a place to be proud of.

This week we held our first meeting with those residents who have volunteered to serve on the Resident Project Group. At the meeting we discussed with residents how we can get as many people as possible involved in making the estate a place to be proud of. We know that not everybody has time to go to regular meetings; but we still want to make sure that everyone has their say on the best ways to improve the estate, build new homes, and make sure there are excellent facilities for local people as the local area grows and changes.
